


Year 3 Term 4 Newsletter

Welcome to Term 4

Welcome back! We hope you enjoyed the half term break!

In term 4, we will be focussing on our class text: *The Sheep-Pig* by Dick King-Smith.



Within our writing this term, we shall be writing to persuade and to entertain, producing different outcomes such as stories and speeches.

In Maths, we will be exploring multiplication and division and learning written methods of these. To supplement this, we will be continuing to regularly practice our 3, 4 and 8 times tables alongside recapping year 2's learning of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will also be covering money and teaching the children how to add amounts of money and also work out the change.

We will continue to link our learning to our texts where it is appropriate within the broader curriculum. Within our History lessons, we will be studying the Roman occupation of Britain and how this has shaped parts of our country today. We will be trying to answer the following question: Why did the Romans settle in Britain?

We have our year 3 play planned which will be all about the Romans. We can't wait to perform for you all.

In Computing, we will be learning about email and communication, teaching the children how to safely send and receive emails. In Art, we will be learning how to make mosaics inspired by the artist, Sonia King. Please can we ask children have an Art t-shirt which is kept in their lockers for the whole term.

We will also have weekly recorders lessons, RE, PSHE, French and Spelling lessons. In Science lessons, we will be learning about animals including humans.

Homework

Homework in Term 4 will be Spellings and either an English or a Maths task that will be linked to that week's learning. We also continue to ask for children to read at home 5 times per week. This will be sent home on a Friday and all homework books and reading books need to be brought back into school every Wednesday.

PE

PE in term 4 will be on a **Monday** This term we will be learning dance. Children need to come to school in their PE kit on this day.
