Year 12 Next Steps....

Year 12 students have access to their UCAS predicted grades on Unifrog. This will help them when considering their next steps

We appreciate that not everyone will be applying to university but still may need predicted grades for prospective employers.

If students are applying to university then by September, they should have a good idea of which subject they are applying for and have a shortlist of universities. Universities will have open days throughout the summer and we would strongly encourage you to attend. Students should also be using Unifrog to make a start on their personal statement.

Your son/daughter should be researching admissions tests and/or any additional work that is required by their chosen universities and/or courses. All information can be found on university websites. Some universities and /or courses have an early deadline.

<u>The UCAS deadline for these courses/universities is 15 October, our internal deadline is 30 September. For all other courses the UCAS deadline is 31 January 2024, our internal deadline is 10 November.</u>

Whilst this may seem early we know that some universities start to give out offers as soon as they receive forms - as an example, we had a student, whose course was a January deadline, they completed their form and it was sent by 1 October, they had received all 5 offers by the end of October.
