Students will manipulate grammar to refer to three tenses and will use a larger range of structures to extend and connect in writing.	Students will build on skills from Module 1 by recognising people's points of view in complex spoken and written language and transcribing sentences with a variety of tenses using regular and irregular verbs. Students will extend and develop ideas in oral communication with accurate pronunciation using three tenses. Students will show comprehension of range of sources by using context to derive meaning. Students will use a range of vocabulary to express justified opinions in writing.	Students will build on skills from Module 2 by recognising the present, past and future in complex spoken and written language from a range of sources and by transcribing sentences with a variety of tenses using regular and irregular verb and complex structures. Students will extend and develop ideas in oral communication with highly accurate pronunciation using three tenses and will develop spontaneity in conversations. Students will use high level structures and three timeframes to express ideas.
