Prepare for GCSE's by checking out the resources the library offer to support your journey

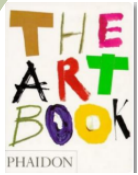

Finish your Reading Route journey for a prize

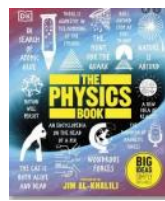


YEAR 9

Join the summer reading program

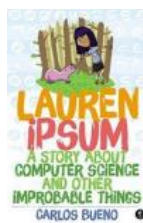
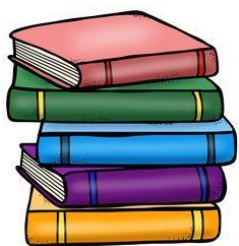

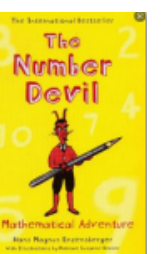
YEAR 8
