



Key Stage 2 Results - 2026

On this page you can find the following results and scores:

- the percentage of children who achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths
- the percentage of children who achieved a high level of attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths

The table below shows the percentage of children who achieved at least the expected standard at the end of Year 6 in Reading, Writing, Maths, RWM (Reading, Writing and Maths combined) and GPS (Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling).

The school's percentages can be compared with the national averages from 2026. In 2026, the percentage of children, from The Ferncumbe CE Primary School, who achieved at least the expected standard was above the national average in every subject – and all subjects combined.
