

Curriculum Information - Year 6

<u>Autumn Term 2 - 30th October – Wednesday 20th December</u>

Dear Parents/Carers,

This half term our topic is: Amazing Amazon. The children will be completing learning related to this topic in: Geography, Music and Art. All other lessons will be taught discreetly.

English	This half term children will be planning and writing their own non-fiction report based around our class book: Arthur Spiderwick's Field Guide to the Fantastical World Around You by Tony DiTerlizzi and Holly Black. This is an amazing book
	and will allow children to delve into the world of mystical animals! Christmas unit - Type of writing produced: Narrative/poetry/diary entry
Maths	Our maths learning this half term will focus on: short and long multiplication, short division and long division, simplifying fractions, comparing and ordering fractions, adding and subtracting fractions, multiplying fractions, dividing fractions, fraction problem solving.
Science	Our science topic this half term is: Living things and their habitats. In this unit children will look at: how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, naming the types of microorganisms and designing their own microorganisms.
PE	This half term we will be looking at: Gymnastics. The children will learn to: combine and perform gymnastic actions, create and perform sequences using compositional devices and use appropriate language to evaluate and refine my own and others' work.
