

Re: Catholic Academy Trust Consultation

As you may recall from our communications over the past few months, the governors of The Holy Family Catholic Primary School have taken the decision to initiate the consultation process regarding the acquisition of academy status and join the Diocese of Westminster Academy Trust with our partner Catholic schools.

This letter is informing you of the consultation, which opens on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April and closes on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2024.

A consultation does not mean we have taken a final decision to convert to an Academy, but that we wish to seek the views of all our community to inform the final decision. To support you in developing your knowledge and understanding of what is involved in becoming an academy we have prepared a questions and answers consultation which will be available from today on the school's website at -

The meeting will include a presentation about what joining the Catholic Academy Trust would mean for the school, and it is another opportunity to ask questions.

We anticipate the meeting will last for approximately 60 minutes, commencing at **5pm on Thursday 9**<sup>th</sup> **May.**
