




Tens Frame - how many? Can you remember and copy this

In Reception children will have recognised quantities up to 5 (without counting each item) They will have compared quantities up to 10, recognising when quantities are more than, less than or the same as the other quantity.

Maths Mastery

Play a game using a tens frame and a dice with a partner

Aim: to fill each space with a total of ten dots.

Rules:

- Roll a dotty dice and record the dots rolled in one of the spaces on the grid.
- · Take turns to roll the dice and add the dots to a square on the grid.
- . The player that rolls the correct value to fill the space with ten dots wins that space on the grid.
- The player who wins the most spaces on the grid is the winner once all the spaces have ten dots.
