This half term our topic in Geography will be: Changes in our Local Environment. The children will be learning about this through DT, Geography and Music. Everything else will be taught discretely.

	based upon the basis of their properties. Understand that sound materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution and describe how to recover a substance from a solution.
PE	This term our P.E will be Dance. PE will take place on a <b>Wednesday</b> . Pupils learn different styles of dance, working individually, as a pair and in small groups. In dance as a whole, pupils think about how to use movement to explore and communicate ideas and issues, and their own feelings and thoughts. Pupils will be provided with the opportunity to create and perform their work. They will be asked to provide feedback.
