

Timeline of Welwyn Garden City

1920s-Welwyn Garden City was founded by Sir Ebenezer Howard.

1921-Welwyn Garden City Football Club, parish and theatre society was founded.

1923-Welwyn Garden City Golf Club was founded.

1927-Welwyn Garden City Urban District, local government district, was created. It was abolished in 1974. 1928-The Welwyn Theatre (later the Embassy cinema) was opened in Parkway as a cinema and theatre.

1931

Welwyn Rugby Football Club was founded.

1931-The population of Welwyn Garden City according to the census was 8,586.

1935-The Welwyn Garden City rail crash occurred on June 15th. A London to Leeds train and a London to Newcastle train, both out of Kings Cross, collided resulting in 13 people being killed and 85 injured.

1971

The population of Welwyn Garden City according to the census was 40,451.

1974

Under the Local Government Act 1972, Welwyn Garden City Urban District was abolished and Welwyn Garden City became part of the newly created Welwyn Hatfield district.

1990

The Howard Centre, shopping centre, was opened in October. It is named after Sir Ebenezer Howard, founder of Welwyn Garden City.
