The five joyful mysteries Mysteries are: The Annunciation. The Visitation. The Nativity, The presentation, The Finding of Jesus in the Temple. A tradition that introduces Jesus' ancestors. It involves telling stories Jesse tree from the old testament. 'Anointed one' Messiah A song that the Virgin Mary sang after Elizabeth told her that she is going to Magnificat give birth to God's son. It is known as the Song of Mary. Used during Advent to symbolise Wreath preparation for Christmas.
