ESSENTIAL VOCABULARY	
Word	Definition
Liturgical year	The Church year is split into different seasons based on the life of Christ. It starts with Advent and ends at the same time the following year.
Ordinary time	This is the season of the Church year when Catholics are encouraged to grow and mature outside of the seasons of celebration.
Seasons	Four different times of the year.
Rosary	Traditional Catholic prayer that seeks to honor Mary, the mother of Jesus.
Feasts	A huge, delicious meal that's served at a party or celebration.
Feasts of Mary	A feast day of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
Pilgrimage	A journey to a holy place.
Psalms	A sacred song or poem used in worship especially one of the biblical hymns.
Incarnation	This shows that Jesus was fully God and fully human. It means to take on flesh.

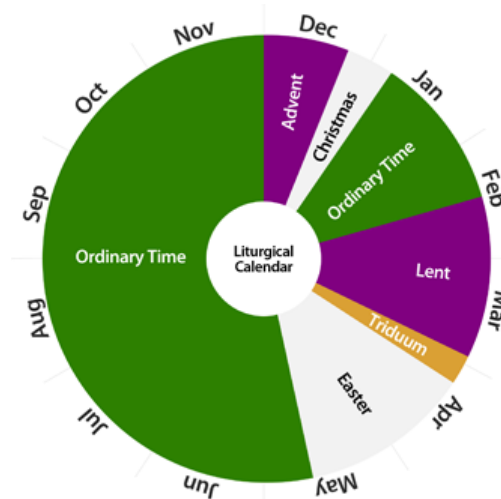
