Vocabulary

Word	Definition	How do I do this?
Backstop	This player stands behind the batter and attempts to catch the ball if hit by the batter.	Stand behind batter and wickets and attempt to catch ball. Also try to catch ball and hit the wicket if batter steps outside of their crease.
Fielder	A fielder is the bowling side. The fielders are spread across the pitch.	They attempt to get the batter out by catching the ball or hitting the wicket.
Batter	Two batters are in play at a time. They try to hit the ball as far as possible.	They can score runs by either running or hitting certain boundaries.
Long barrier	A technique used to catch a rolling ball.
