Teacher Glossary

Word	Definition	How do I do this?
Pass	Giving the ball to another player on the same team.	In rugby, can only pass the ball to player behind you or next to you, no forward passing.
Dodge	Avoiding another player.	Quick movement to avoid player on other team and avoid being tagged.
Tag	Having tag from tag belt taken by opposing team.	Tagging in rugby is where another player removes your tag from your tag belt. The tags are either worn on side or back of belt.
Defend	Protecting a goal or tag.	Defending in tag rugby, can look like protecting the goal area where the opposing team are trying to score or dodging opposing team to defend tag belt.
