




Outdoor Library

Nursery afternoon sessions

If your child is part time and you would like them to stay 1 or more afternoons per week please speak to the school office.

The current cost of an afternoon session is £17.50 per day with effect from 1st April 2024. This is in line with Hertfordshire County Council funding. We also accept the 30 hour funding code or payment through the government tax free childcare scheme.
