

Uniform

PE kit

Children should be wearing:

- Holy Family sports PE top
- Plain back shorts (plain trousers/leggings in the colder weather)
- Plain black hoodie/zip up top

There should be no logo's on the trousers or hoodie.

Long hair

Long hair should be tied back throughout the school day. Jewellery should not be worn except for plain stud earrings which must be removed on P.E days. Haircuts should be sensible, no extreme styles or shaving and of a natural colour. Any hair accessories should be neutral or in school colours.

Building fund, are you contributing?

As a voluntary aided school we are required by law to raise 10% of the cost of developing and maintaining the upkeep of the interior/exterior and fabric of the school building and for any new buildings. To help cover these cost we are ask parents where possible to pay a voluntary contribution towards this. Our suggested donations are:

One child: £4 monthly or £48 annually Two children: £8 monthly or £96 annually

Three or more children £10 monthly or £120 annually

If you are a UK tax payer in addition to your contributions we are also able to claim the gift aid on these donations. Please contact the school office if you require a form to set up a payment.

Nursery

In Nursery we have been reading the story Jasper's Beanstalk to start our topic of growing. We imagined what we would find at the top of a beanstalk and drew a picture. We mixed our own green paint and used different sized brushes to create our own beanstalks. We also enjoyed digging and sorting vegetables in our tuff tray.













Reception

In Reception, we started a new topic 'Traditional tales' by reading "The Three Little Pigs". We designed houses for Mr. Wolf and wrote about them to encourage Mr Wolf to choose our design. We painted the houses, thinking carefully of the colours, which we created by mixing ready paints. We also built new houses for three little pigs using different construction materials.
