ESSENTIAL VOCABULARY	
Word	Definition
Sign of the Cross	This is made by touching one's right hand to the forehead first (Father), then to the lower chest or stomach (Son), then to the left shoulder and the right shoulder (Holy Spirit), and closing with both our hands together - Amen
Sacrament	The celebration of God's presence at special moments in our lives.
Baptism	The first sacrament. An invitation to join the Church family.
godparents	Represent the Church and help the child to grow in faith.
Font	Where the water of baptism is poured
