


Painting Year 1

Key Vocabulary	
Word	Definition
Primary colour	The primary colours are red, yellow and blue and from them all other colours can be made
Secondary colour	The secondary colours are orange, green and violet. We get these by mixing 2 colours together.
Warm colour	Reds, oranges, yellow and browns which can make you feel such things as anger or warmth
Cool colour	Cool colours such as green or blue can be thought of as calming.

Skills
