

Curriculum Information - Year 1

<u>Autumn 2- 30th October – 20th December 2023</u>

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to a busy half term! A lot of work will go into producing a wonderful Nativity this half term. Many children will have lines to learn for this, so please help at home to ensure that your child is confident with their words. P.E. and outdoor learning will remain on Thursday. Homework is currently provided on google classroom. For this half term this will be phonics and reading, plus Nativity lines to learn. After Christmas, I will also provide maths homework. This half term our topic will focus on Toys. English will be linked to key books with daily phonics and reading sessions. Maths and R.E. will be taught discretely.

Toys	
English	This half term we will focus largely on phonics and getting the children to write complete
	sentences with Capital letters, full stops and finger spaces between words.
	For the second half of this half term we will focus on the text 'The jolly Christmas
	postman. The children will write a letter to Santa in their best handwriting.
Maths	This half term in maths children will firstly focus on number, problem solving and shape.
	We will write the numbers to twenty in numerals and recognise the words (e.g.
	nineteen). We will also look at odd and even numbers. we will look at counting on in
	addition, subtracting a part from the whole and doubling and halving. We will then look
	at 2D and 3D shapes.
Science	Our science topic is materials. We will name, describe and sort a variety of materials and
	will then look at materials that are best to make a boat and how the shape of the
	material affects whether it floats or sinks.
PE	We will have a PE session every Thursday and children should come to school dressed in
	their PE kit every Thursday. This half term we will focus on gymnastics and will learn to
	sequence movements and repeat them to show others.
RE	In R.E. we will learn about Hinduism and then will focus on Advent and Christmas.
Humanities	History - Our history topic is toys. We will be looking at differences between toys we play
Arts	with and toys in the past.
Computing	DT - We will be designing and making a nativity stable with characters.
	Computing - We will sort objects in different ways using the computer and we will then
	create and use pictograms made on the computer.
Home	Homework:
Learning	Reading (1 library books and 1 reading book per week)
	Phonics activity. Learning lines for the Nativity. Maths Numbot practice.
