

## **Curriculum Information - Year 2**

## Autumn Term 2 –30th October – 20<sup>th</sup> December 2023

Dear Parents/Carers,

This half term our topic will focus on the gunpowder plot and the Great Fire of London. English will be linked to key books with spelling and guided reading sessions inbetween. Maths and R.E. will continue to be taught discretely.

English	This half term by focusing on the texts Scaredy Squirrel by Melanie Watt and How To Make
	Friends with a Ghost by Rebecca Green. Children will be writing lists and instructions. We will also
	be developing skills needed to write poetry.
Maths	This half term in maths children will focus on number skills. This will include developing their
	mental calculation skills, adding and subtracting 1 and 2 digit numbers and finding complements
	to 10 and 100. Children will also be learning how to make totals of money using different
	combination of coins and finding change.
Science	Our science topic is Everyday Materials. Children will learn to identify and name different
	materials and explain why they are suitable for their use. We will carry out simple tests such as
	finding the best material to mend a hole in a bucket.
PE/LOTC	PE and Learning outside the classroom lessons will continue to happen on a Monday. In our PE
	lessons the children will be taking part in Dance lessons and learning all the skills required to make their own dance.
RE	In R.E. we will learn about the rite of baptism and the signs and symbols in baptism. Children will
	recognition that members of the Church family act in a particular way because they are following
	the light of Christ. We will also be spending a week looking at the Hindu faith with a focus on
	prayer.
	We will learn that advent is four weeks of preparing and about the symbolism of the Advent
	Wreath. Children will focus on the nativity story and learn about the annunciation. We will learn
Humanities	that Jesus comes to us as God's gift  History - Our history topic is about Guy Fawkes and the gunpowder plot and the Great Fire of
Arts	London. Children will learn why the fire spread so quickly and a timeline of the key events.
Computing	DT- In DT lessons the children will be working with Mrs Balicki to make their own fire engines
computing	using different moving parts.
	Music - In music Mrs Kee will be preparing Year 2 for their nativity play.
Home	Homework will be set every Friday on Google Classroom:
Learning	Reading ( 1 library books and 1 reading book per week)
	Spelling activity each week and a weekly activity linked to maths or topic work.
