Attendance & punctuality

Good attendance at school is vital, particularly after the last 18 months of disrupted schooling and is directly linked to academic success.

 School gates open at 8:45 am and close promptly at 9am arrival after this should be via the school office. Arrivals later than 9.15am will be marked as unauthorised absence.

<u>Illnesses</u>

- Should your child be unable to attend school due to illness you must inform the school office by 9.30am. After this time the school office will phone to find out the reason for absence. If we are unable to make contact by 10.30am a member of the senior leadership team may make a home visit for safeguarding purposes.
- Leave of absence holidays should not be taken during term time and cannot be authorised. In exceptional circumstances some absences may be authorized at the discretion of the head teacher.
- End of day -3.15pm it is important that you arrive on time to collect your child. If you are later than 3.25pm your child will go to our after school care facility and you will be charged for the session.



Revise Phase 5 phonemes





- Plain black jogging bottoms and black trainers.




