

## Year 9 French Long-Term Plan

**Rationale:** In Year 9 students will continue to develop their language skills and will be introduced to a greater variety of verb tenses and grammar points. Over the course of the year, students will consolidate their linguistic skills, write at length using more complex structures and develop their fluency, knowledge and recall of language.
