Please encourage your child to complete **The Big Future** survey. Their responses will contribute to a national picture of childhood and help inform future decisions affecting children and young people.

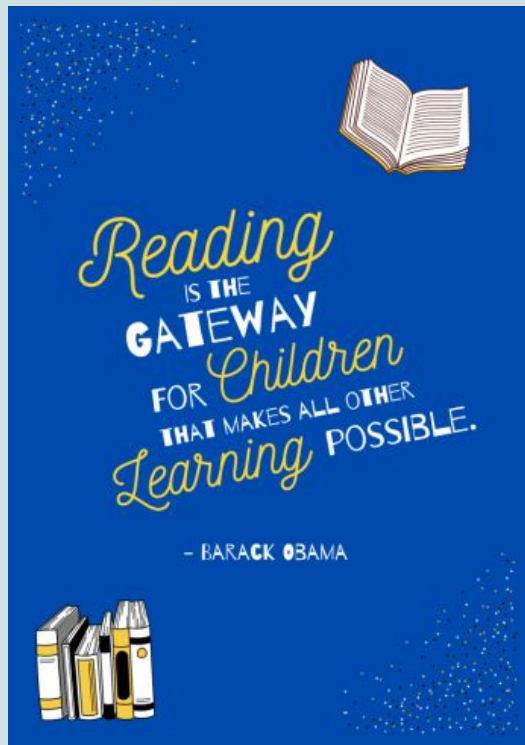

Clubs will take place from 3-4.15 (approx)

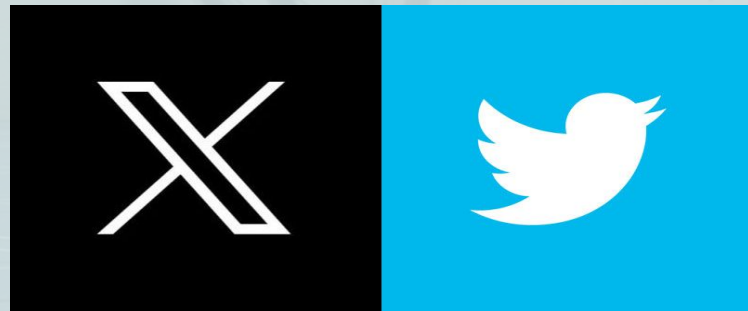

The Kingsway Achievement World Cup



How it works

A small mini team will be established in each form. As individuals they will receive achievement points as follows:

- ❑ Captain (decided by their form tutor) points count as **triple**.
- ❑ Vice captain (decided by their form) points count as **double**.
- ❑ Total form achievement points count for **bonus goals**.
- ❑ Each week points are added up and forms move up and down the table.
- ❑ The winning form gets a form reward in the last week of term...watch this space!

Mini team points

- 1 point - 100% attendance
- 1 point - 100% Positive Logs
- 1 point - Perfect Punctuality

Whole form points

- 5 points - Form with highest achievement points
- 5 points - Form with lowest negative logs
- 10 points - Improvement on last week's positive logs

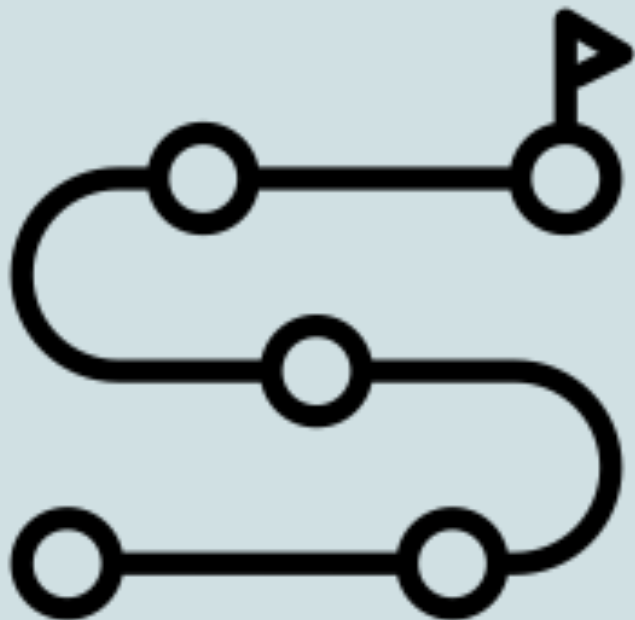
