	Create You all deserve to be physically and emotionally safe, so every adult working in school tries hard to create a safe environment and culture for you to learn in.
	Relate Adults working in school value you and look for the positives in you. Having mutually respectful relationships with staff in school is important because it helps keep you safe.
	Prevent Preventing any harm that might come to you is our priority. We teach you about all kinds of risks to your physical and mental wellbeing so that we can avoid them.
	Respond If something happens that affects your safety or wellbeing, all staff are trained to listen to your concerns. Specialist staff know how to get you the extra support you might need.
	Empower We empower you to talk about all kinds of equality. We ensure students who say or do prejudiced things learn from their mistake. We want you to 'call out' inappropriate things.
	Communicate Your teachers communicate with each other, your families and other adults who might work with you. This supports your development and wellbeing.

We look forward to seeing you there!

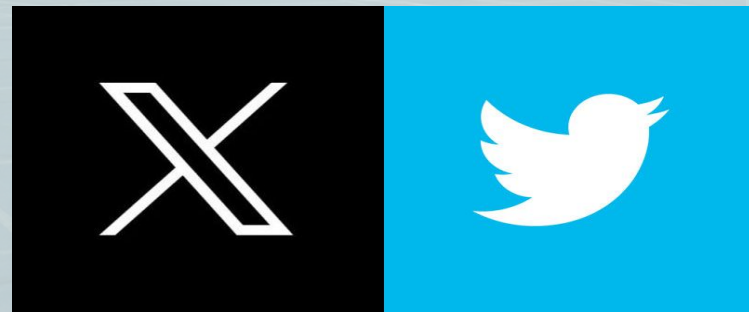

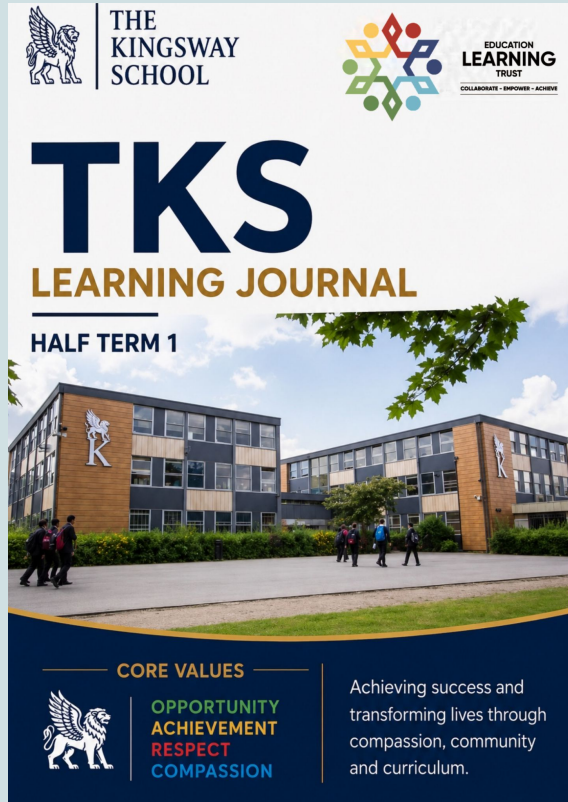

READY-RESPECT-SAFE



Every pupil has the right to learn in an environment free from unnecessary disruption. Every member of the school community therefore has a responsibility to protect learning time.

Teachers will establish clear expectations, teach routines and respond to behaviour consistently. Pupils are expected to follow instructions, engage with learning and allow others to learn without disruption.

If your child receives a C3 or C4 they will be expected to either attend a 15 or 30 min same day detention. This will be scheduled over lunch time or at the end of the school day (depending on when the detention is issued).

Classcharts is our reporting/tracking system to monitor positive interactions and negative incidents. It also reports when your child has been set a detention and if they attended. Please contact your child's year team if you have any questions.
