Your child's Year 9 transition week takes place Monday 29th June - Thursday 2nd July.

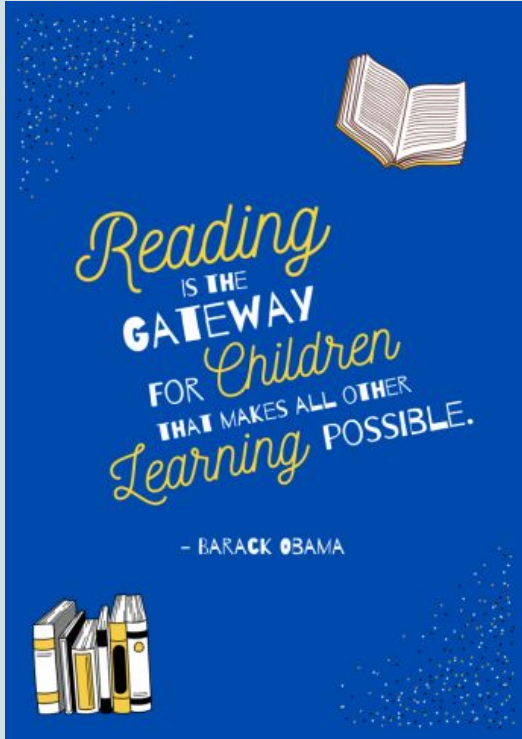
Over the week, your child will gradually increase their time spent on Foxland resulting in a full day on Foxland on Thursday 2nd July.

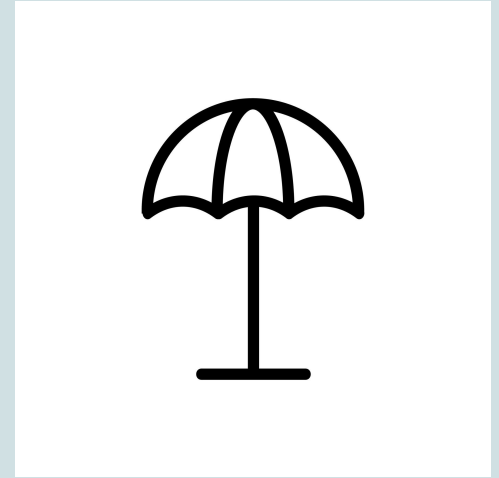

# The Kingsway Achievement World Cup



## How it works

A small mini team will be established in each form. As individuals they will receive achievement points as follows:

- ❑ Captain (decided by their form tutor) points count as **triple**.
- ❑ Vice captain (decided by their form) points count as **double**.
- ❑ Total form achievement points count for **bonus goals**.
- ❑ Each week points are added up and forms move up and down the table.
- ❑ The winning form gets a form reward in the last week of term...watch this space!

### Mini team points

- 1 point - 100% attendance
- 1 point - 100% Positive Logs
- 1 point - Perfect Punctuality

### Whole form points

- 5 points - Form with highest achievement points
- 5 points - Form with lowest negative logs
- 10 points - Improvement on last week's positive logs

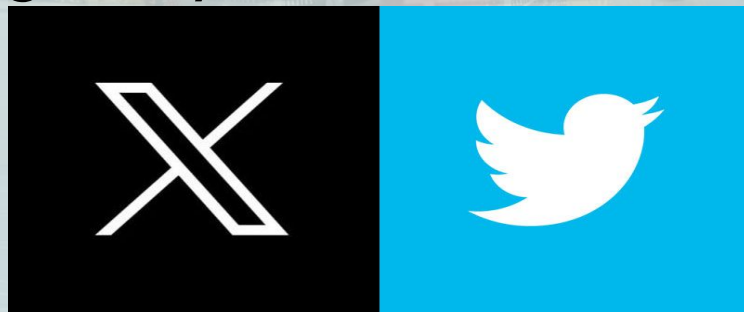

### 1. Team names must be appropriate

Students should use their **first initial and surname** as the manager name for their team. For example: **J Smith / A Patel / M Williams**

This will help us identify students on the leaderboard and award prizes correctly.

### 3. Family entries are welcome

Families may support students with their team, but each student entry should still be clearly linked to the student using their first initial and surname.

### 4. One main entry per student

Students should only enter one main team into the Kingsway league so the competition remains fair.

### 5. Staff may also enter

Staff are welcome to join the league and compete alongside students and families.

### 6. Inappropriate entries will be removed

Any team with an inappropriate name or unclear manager details will be removed from the league or excluded from prizes.

### 7. Play in the right spirit

This is a fun school competition. Please compete positively, enjoy the tournament, and show good sportsmanship throughout.

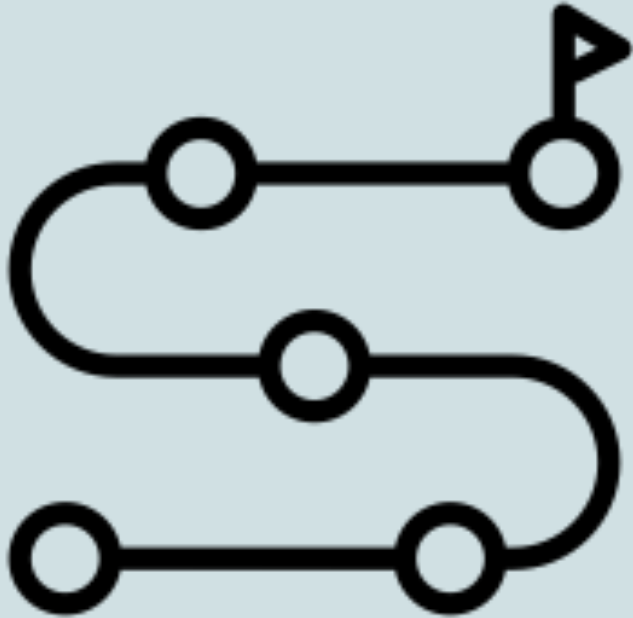
