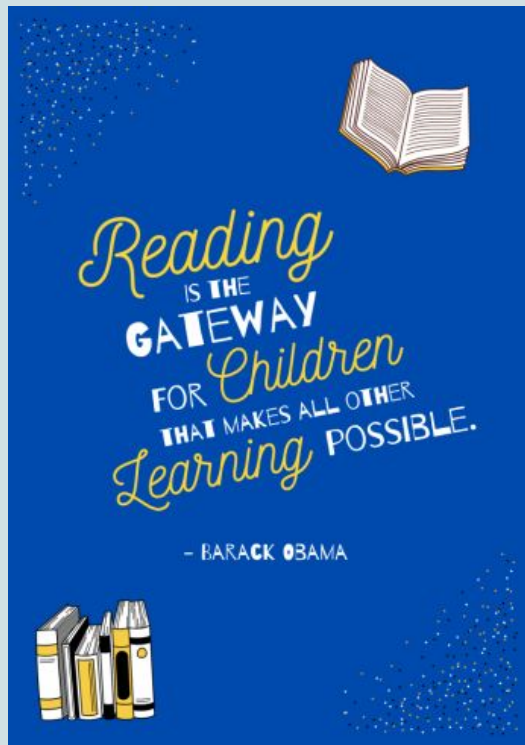

The Kingsway Achievement World Cup



How it works

A small mini team will be established in each form. As individuals they will receive achievement points as follows:

- ❑ Captain (decided by their form tutor) points count as **triple**.
- ❑ Vice captain (decided by their form) points count as **double**.
- ❑ Total form achievement points count for **bonus goals**.
- ❑ Each week points are added up and forms move up and down the table.
- ❑ The winning form gets a form reward in the last week of term...watch this space!

Mini team points

- 1 point - 100% attendance
- 1 point - 100% Positive Logs
- 1 point - Perfect Punctuality

Whole form points

- 5 points - Form with highest achievement points
- 5 points - Form with lowest negative logs
- 10 points - Improvement on last week's positive logs

You will NOT have access to the changing rooms.

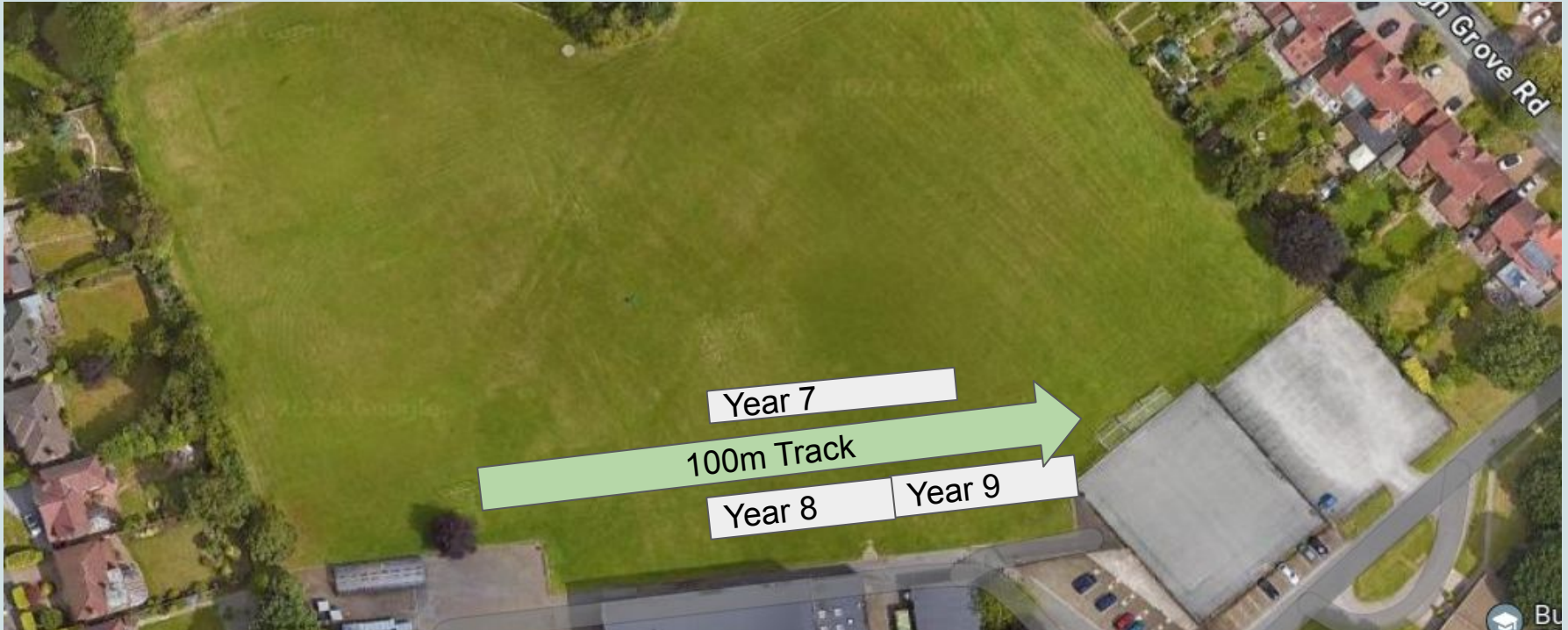
We will NOT be lending out any PE kit.

If it is very hot, please allow years 8 and 9 to sit near the sports hall to get some shade. (Year 7 should have gazebos)

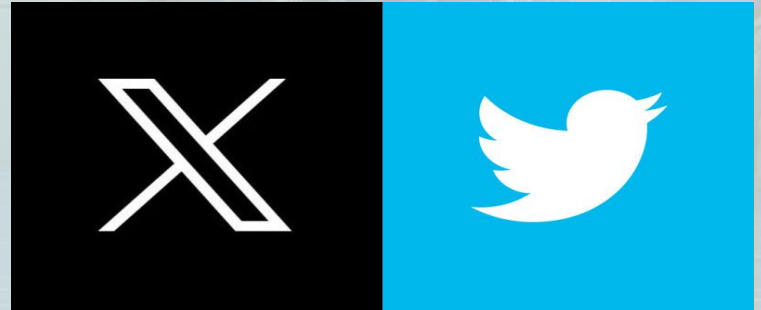

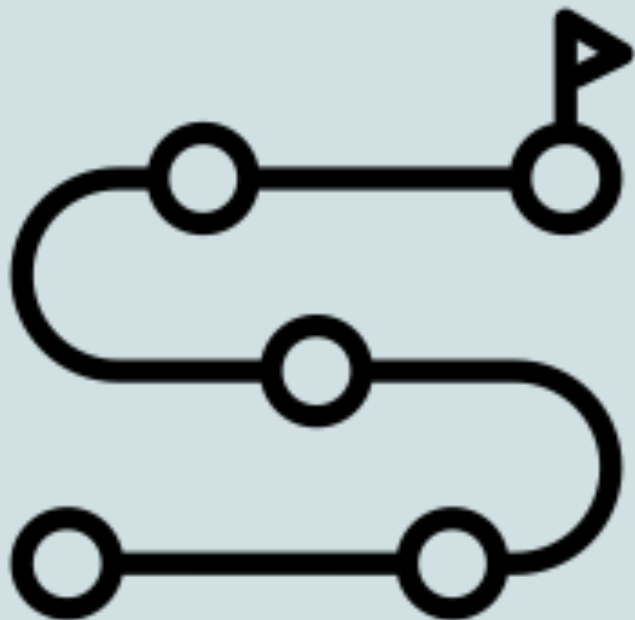
