





## Compassion: Stockport Youth Worker drop-in







## Cornerstone Curriculum Preview: Do you know your child's online footprint?

In this week's Cornerstone form time session, students will discuss the impact of "online bullying".

There will be a focus on the following:

- Distribution of hateful speech.
- Dissemination of photos.
- Impact of negative content on the receiver.

Please discuss this with your child ensuring that they fully understand the consequences of using hateful speech online. In addition, they will be reminded how to report instances of online bullying.




