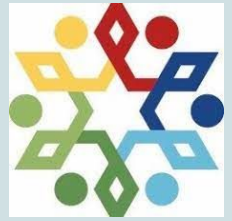

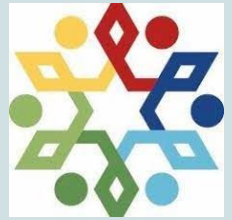

Big Wins

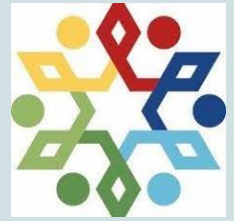

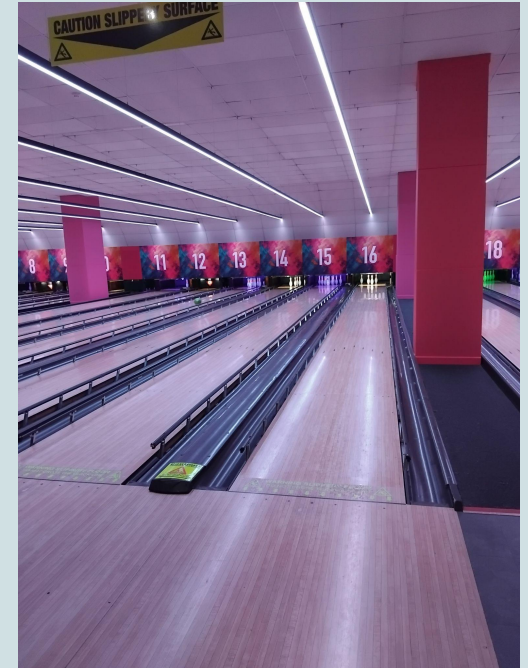


Year 7/8 students invited to our TKS Bowling Trip on Friday 24th January need the following information:

3533 Hours and have read 1368 books!

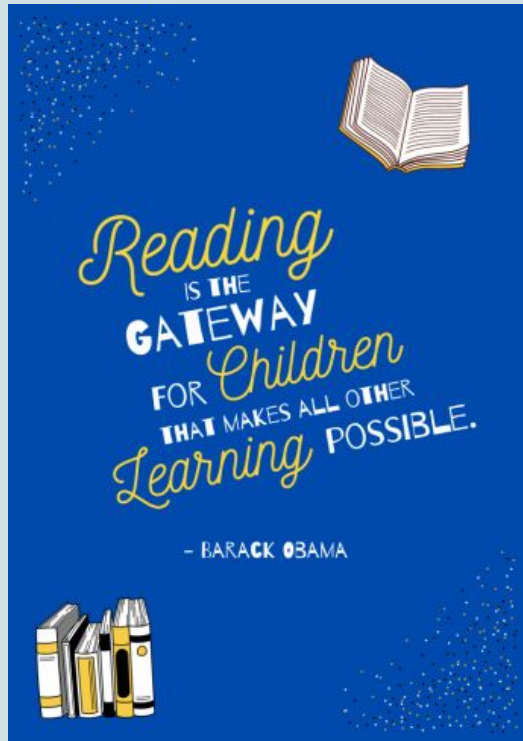

Year 9 Options

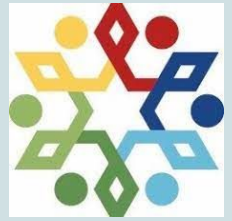
During the Spring Term Year 9 students will be making important choices regarding which subjects they wish to continue studying at Key Stage 4 (Years 10 & 11).

We have maintained a broad curriculum which provides the best foundation for the next stage in student careers. All students will need to select four subjects to study in addition to the core curriculum (maths, English language, English literature, science, PPE and PE).

You now need to start a minimum of one section online and submit it for approval to Miss Horsey.

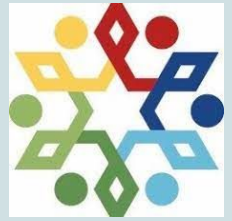
You will be added to a Duke of Edinburgh google classroom - accept this invite and you will get access to support videos for uploading evidence, assessor reports and example activities you can do for each section.
