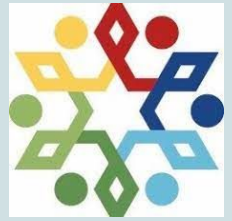

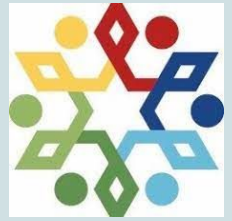

This week's assemblies are going to focus on 'Home Learning' and the things that you can do outside of the classroom in order to succeed academically.

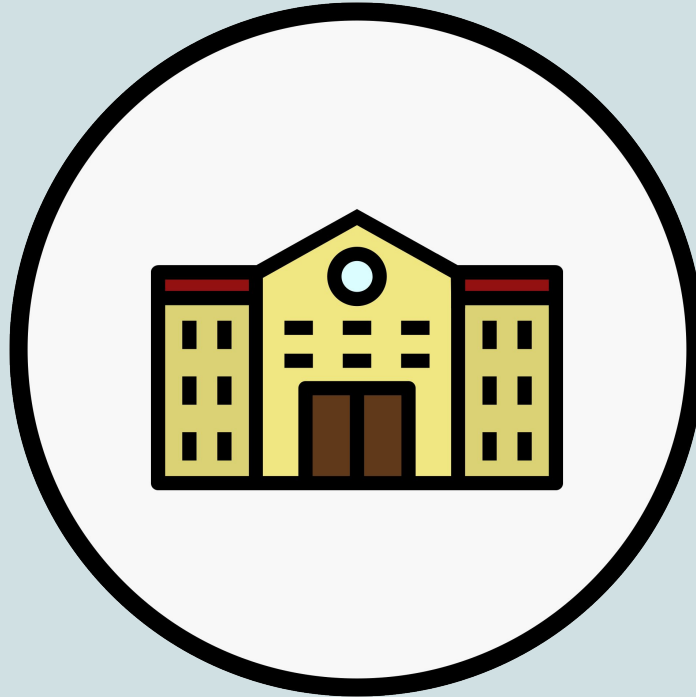

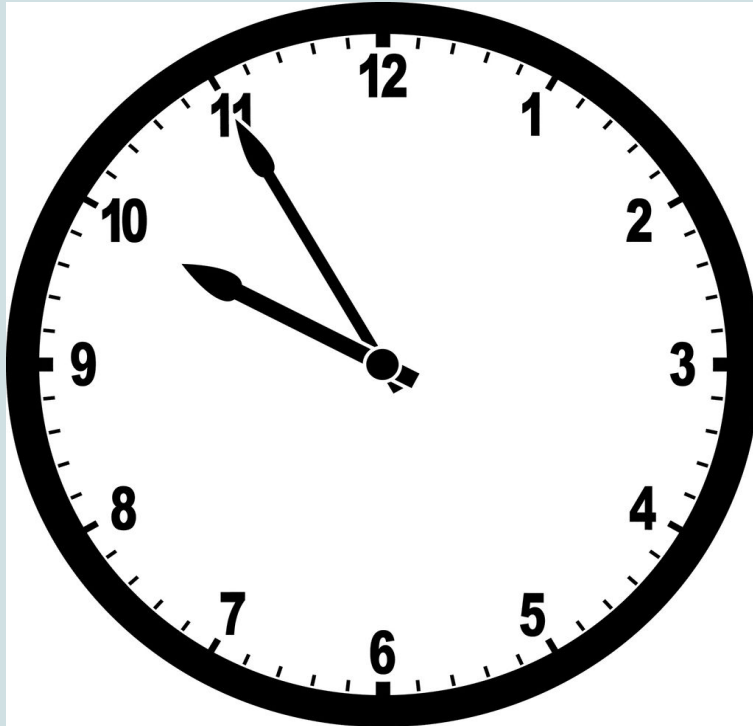
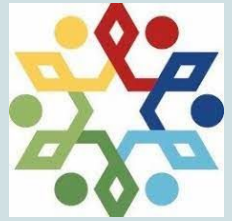


84% of you retained your **“0 negatives”** last week which means you are meeting our ready to learn expectations in all areas of TKS life.

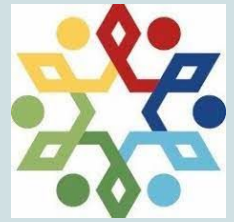
Are you on time to your lessons?

# Respect



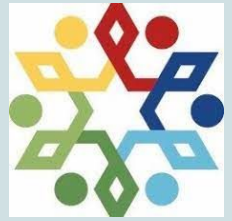
Being kind can be rewarded on Classcharts. All staff in school want to “**catch students being kind**”.
