### Spotlight Knowledge: Forms of government

Forms of government	Definition
Absolute Monarchy	A form of government in which a king or queen rules with unlimited power, e.g. England before King John signed the Magna Carta in 1215.
Constitutional Monarchy	Political power is shared between the monarch and an elected government, such as parliament, e.g. the UK today.
Empire	A group of countries or regions ruled over by a single ruler or state, e.g. the British Empire in the 16 <sup>th</sup> -20 <sup>th</sup> century.
Democracy	A system of government where elected representatives make decisions that represent the interests of all eligible members of the state (voters), e.g. the UK after 1832.
Dictatorship	A country run by a leader who possesses absolute power, e.g. Adolf Hitler in Germany, 1933-45.

### Ready-Respect-Safe Expectations




We will be capturing how you travel to school this week in a short form time survey.





Moving forward, you will be reminded when these are coming up in these messages.




### Respect
