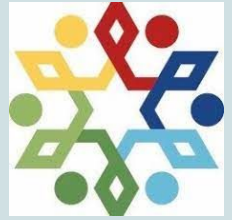


The Kingsway School Broadway Key Messages





Welcome Address



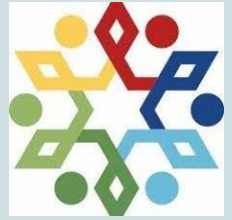

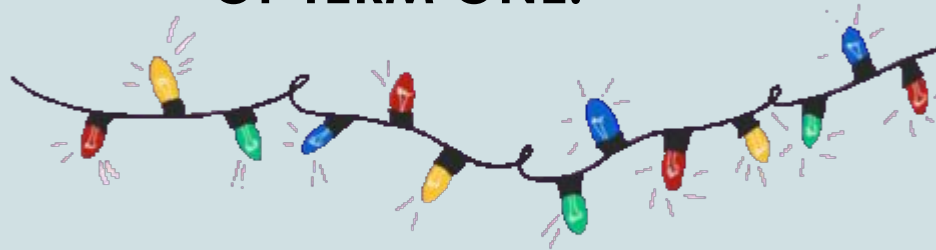
Many subjects will be completing the curriculum and some assessments this week and I wish you luck with these as well as a safe and happy holiday season. Mr Sadler.

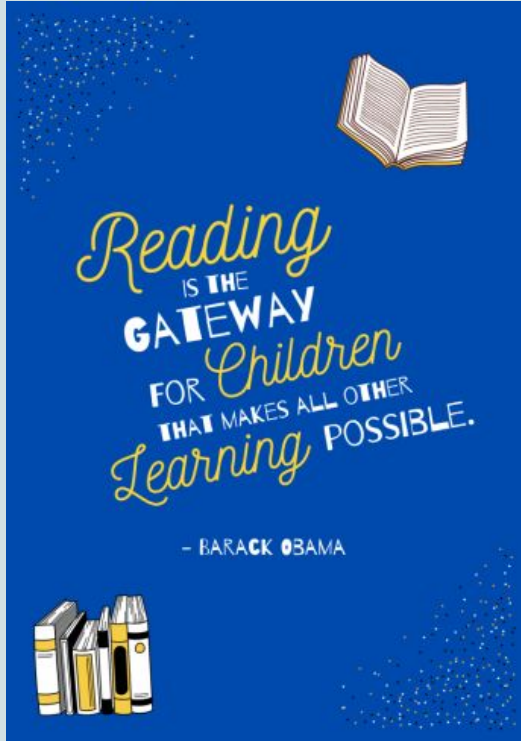
SPARX READER measures the amount of 'careful reading' we do collectively as a school. So far this year, you have read for:

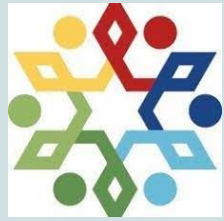

End of term arrangement



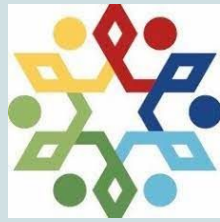
- Expect to be learning as usual in your lessons this week.

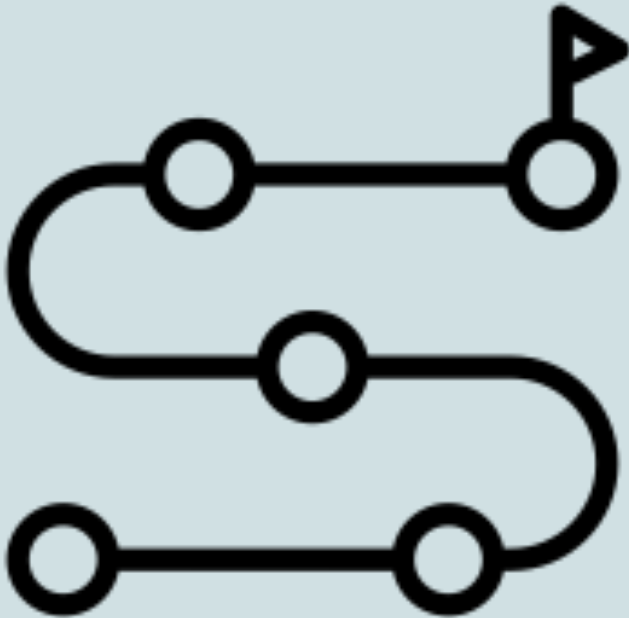
Achievement
