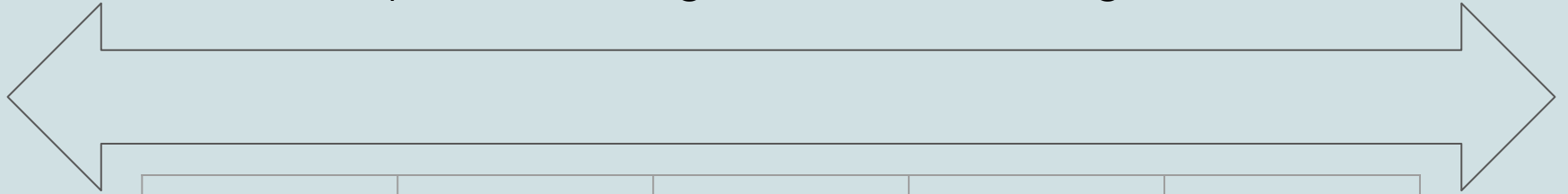







# Day 1 Daily Review: The Five Most Popular UK Political Parties

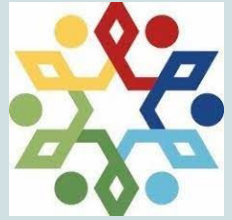

- For us to give challenge and support for anybody who cannot meet our high standards

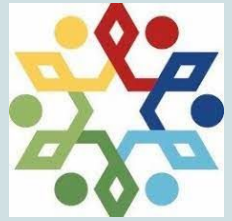

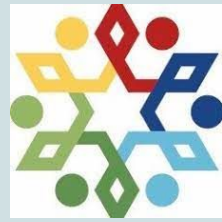
## Big Wins

# Achievement



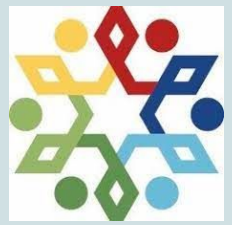
At TKS, you will often hear your teachers talk about your 'learning journey' and the key bits of 'essential knowledge' you will learn as you move through school.

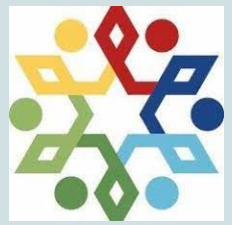

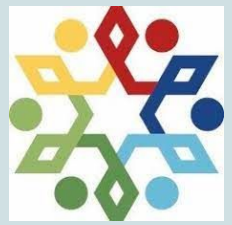

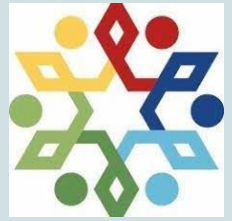
