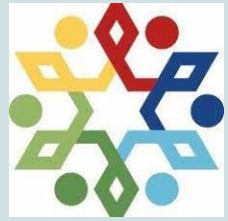

Ready, Respect, Safe No Jewellery allowed



From today:

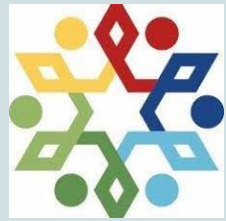
- All jewellery will be confiscated if seen on you in school.
- This means you need to stop and engage with staff members who ask you to remove your jewellery and deposit it into a brown envelope.

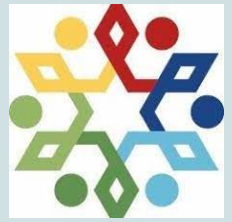

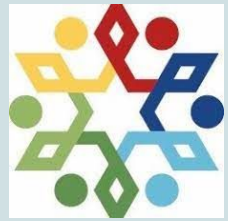

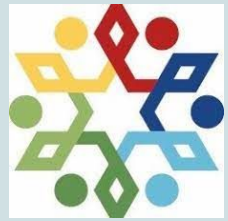

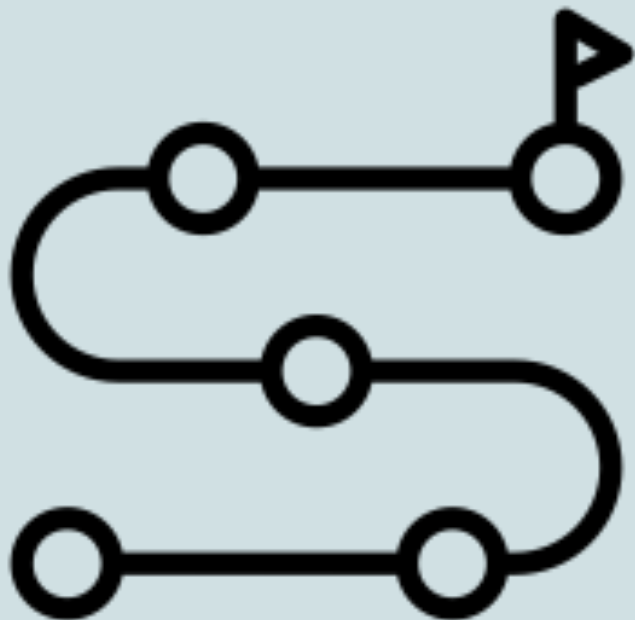


All the requirements of the Diploma have to be evidenced. It is not enough just to have a signature from your class teacher.

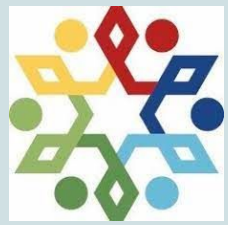
At TKS, you will often hear your teachers talk about your 'learning journey' and the key bits of 'essential knowledge' you will learn as you move through school.

As part of our ongoing commitment to supporting the academic progress and personal development of all our students, we have identified students that would benefit from additional support through our KS3 intervention programme.

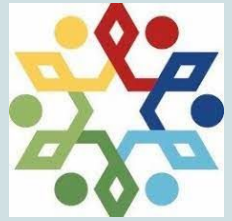
