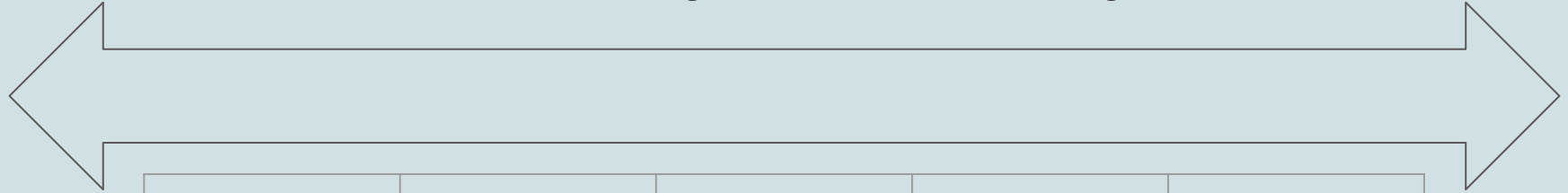

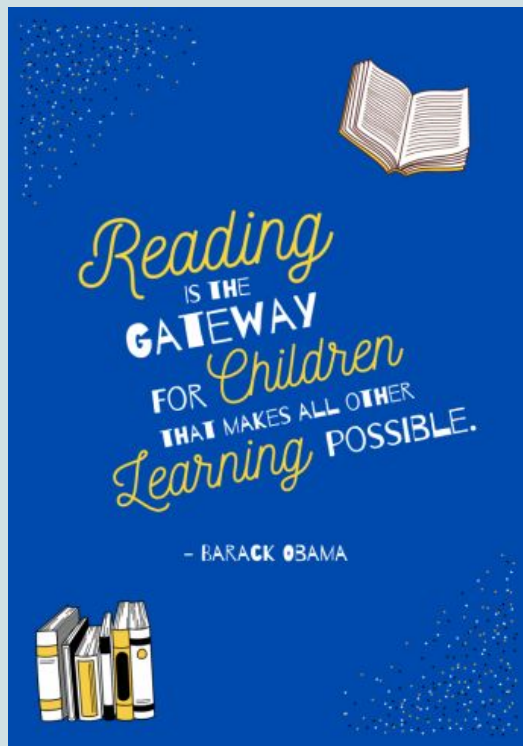

Year 7 - 75% of students in the year group.

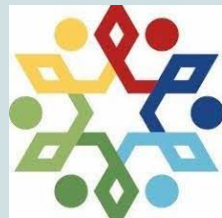

100% attendance for a week: merits and entry to a weekly prize draw, one for each year group.

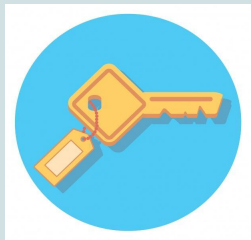
The top 3 forms in each group will receive extra merits.

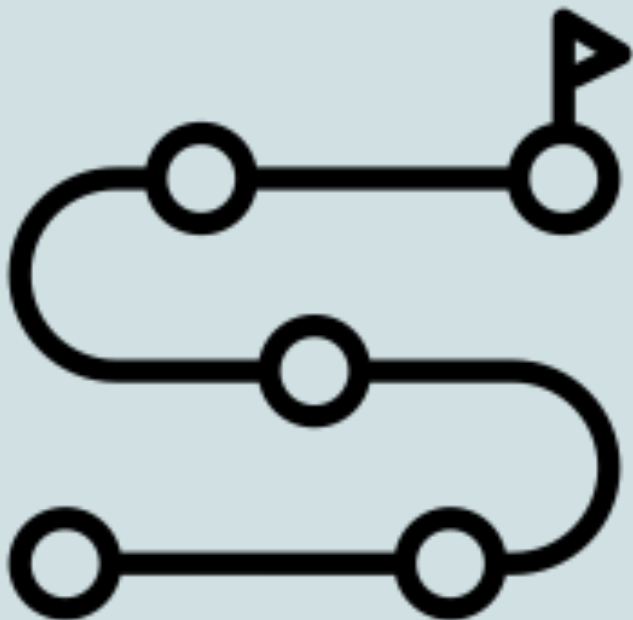
# Love To Read - Broadway

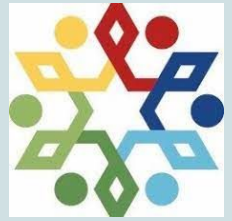

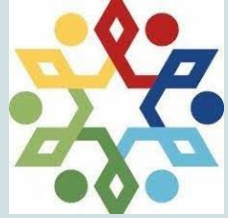

**During Break 1 every day this week, you will have the opportunity to see what a completed Diploma portfolio looks like.**

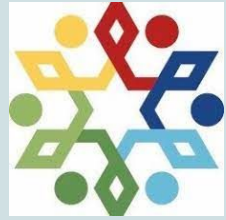
**The year 10s have kindly loaned their Diploma portfolios and these will be presented at the back of Broadway Hall so you can see the expectations.**
