Welcome Address



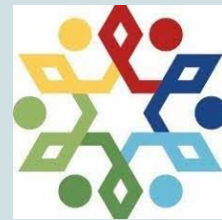

A huge well done to you and bring on **1st July** and the thrill of the rides.

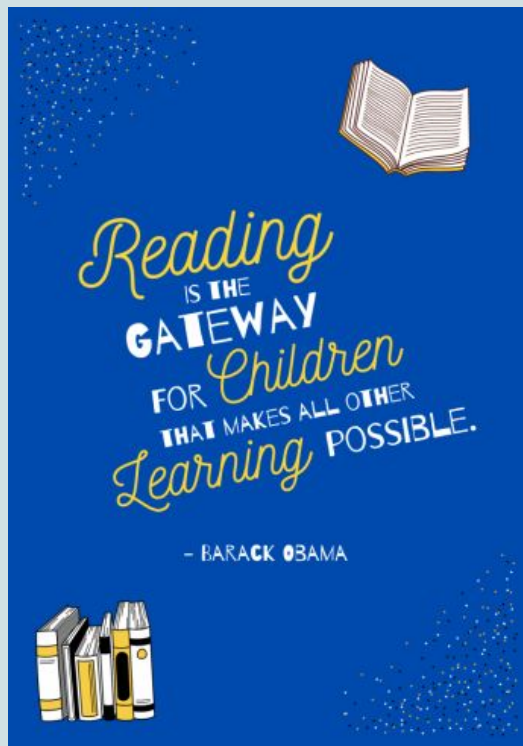

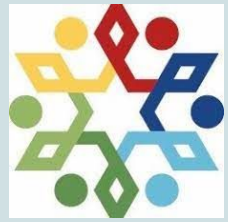


School Ties for 2025/26

KS3 Diploma Exhibition

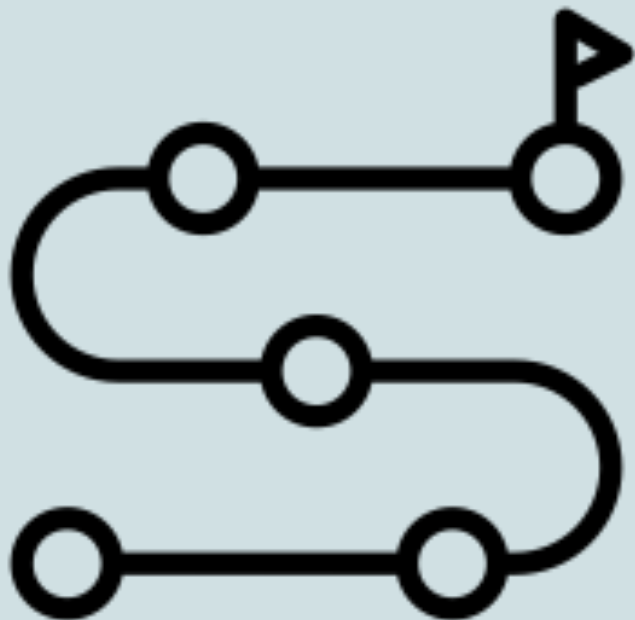


During Break 1 every day this week, you will have the opportunity to see what a completed Diploma portfolio looks like.

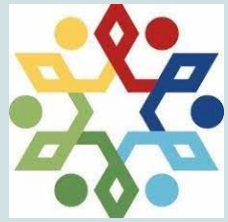
