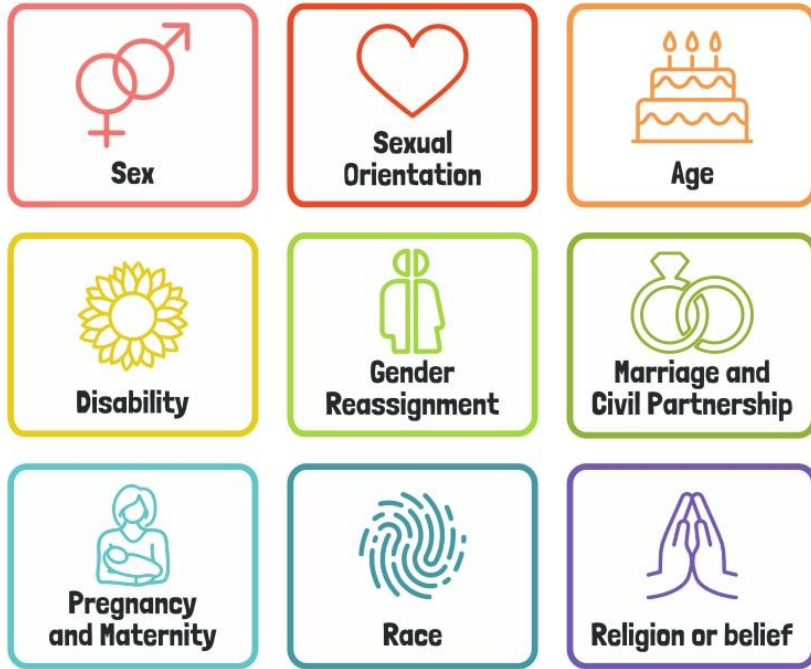

Have a great week and take every opportunity you get. Mr Sadler

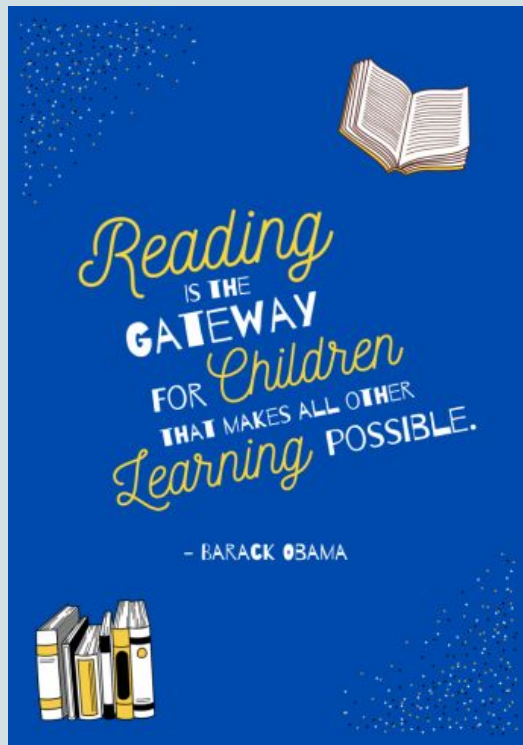
Big Wins

Wow, well done Year 7 and 8. Last week 95% of all the points issued to both year groups were positive points.

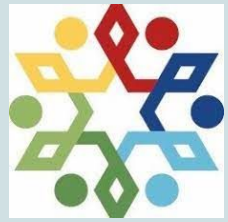
