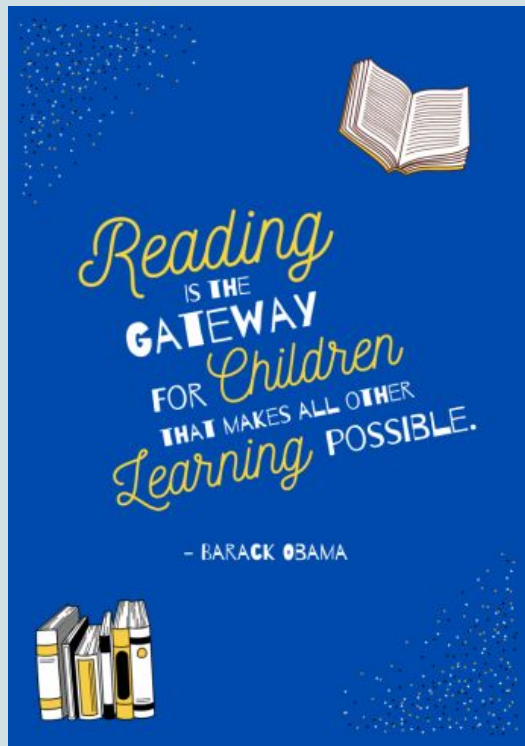
Big Wins

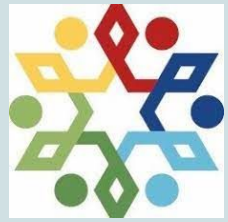
REVIEW DAY: YESTERDAY

KS3 Diploma Exhibition

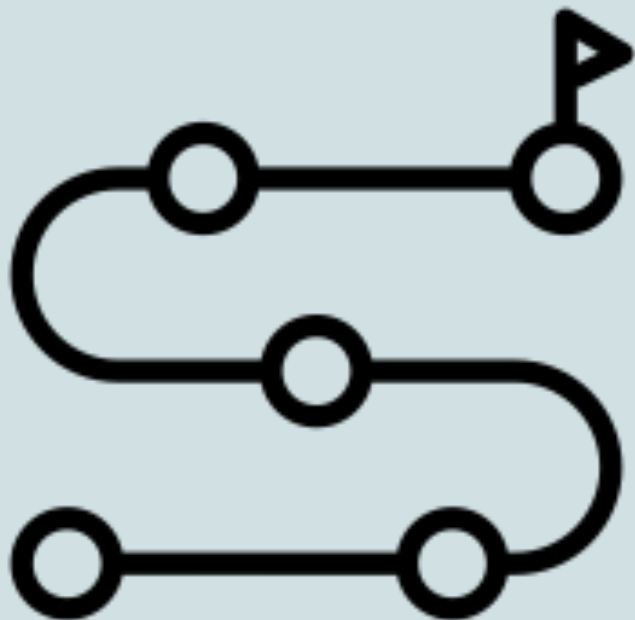


During Break 1 every day this week, you will have the opportunity to see what a completed Diploma portfolio looks like.

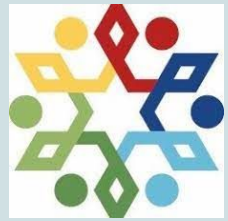
