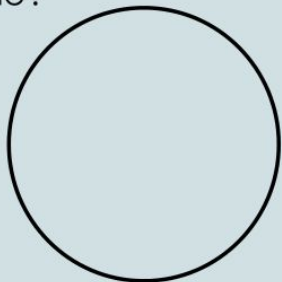


Daily review is an important component of instruction. It helps strengthen the connections of the material learned. Automatic recall frees working memory for problem solving and creativity.

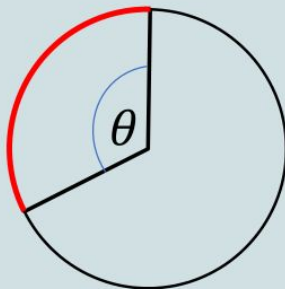
How do we calculate the **circumference** and **area** of a circle?



Circumference = $\pi \times \text{diameter}$

Area = $\pi \times \text{radius}^2$

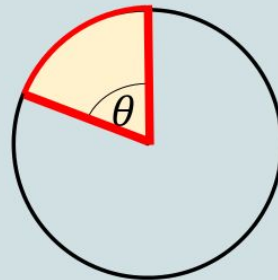
What is the **arc** of a circle and how do we calculate its length?



An **arc** is part of the circumference of a circle.

Arc length = $\frac{\theta}{360} \times \text{circumference}$

What is the **sector** of a circle and how do we calculate its area?



A **sector** is a portion of the circle, enclosed by 2 radii and an arc between them.

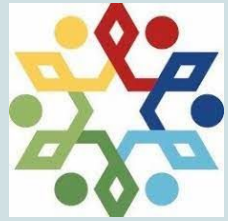
Sector area = $\frac{\theta}{360} \times \text{area of circle}$

Welcome Address



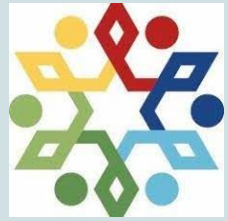

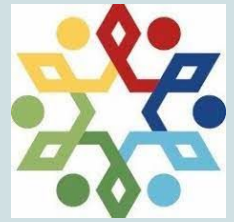


Please remember the following reminders about 'review day' appointments:

Congratulations to all those participating in tomorrow's events. Have an awesome day!

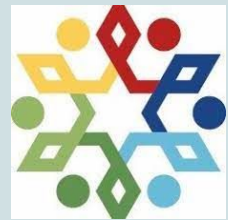

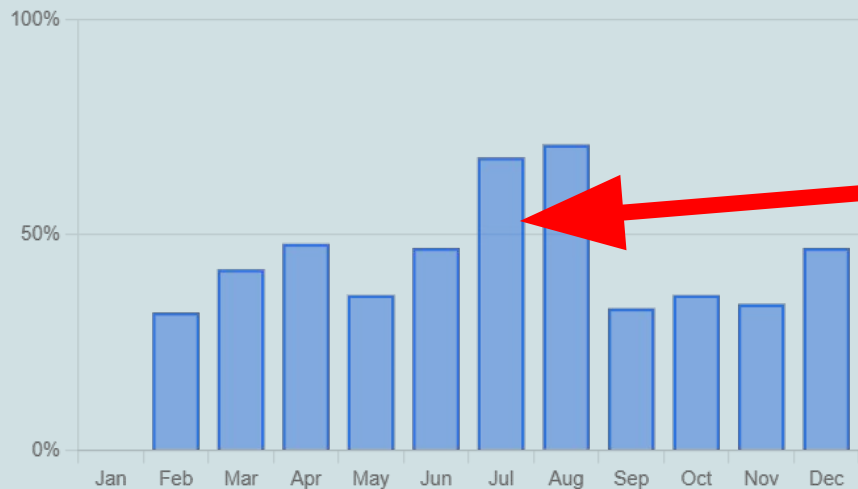

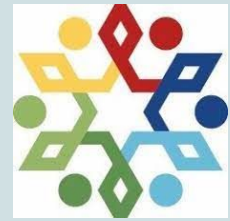
This graph indicates **CROWD LEVELS** at Blackpool Pleasure Beach.

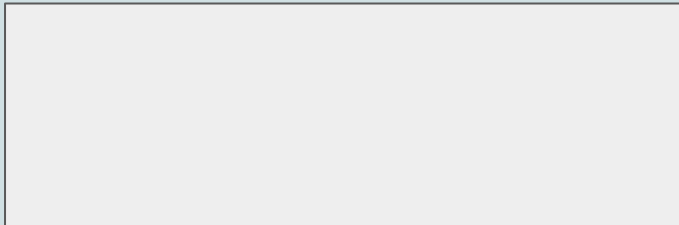
