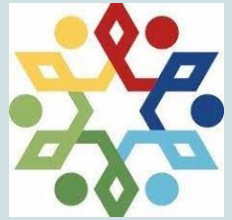

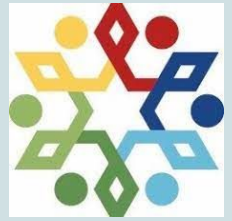
Year 10 will continue to prepare and complete milestones over the next few weeks. Forming good habits now regarding planning and revision strategies will help you along your GCSE journey.

More than 200 Year 10/11 students achieved 100% attendance for the first half term.

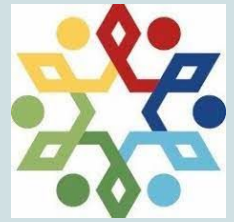
There is a strong link between attendance to school and positive GCSE outcomes. Everyday in school makes a difference.

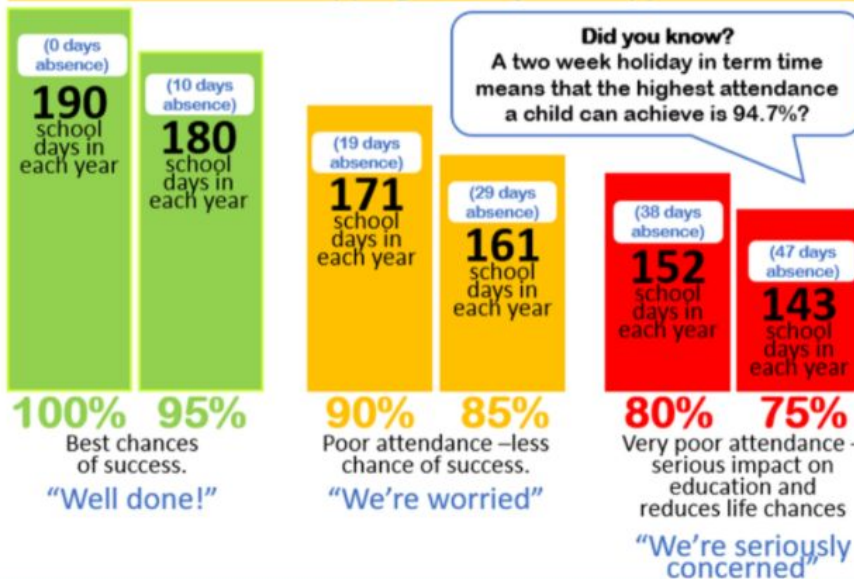
Ready-Respect-Safe Attendance

We do not tolerate:

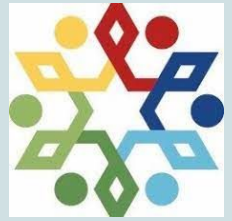
- Unkind language

This will be discussed in more detail in your assembly this week.





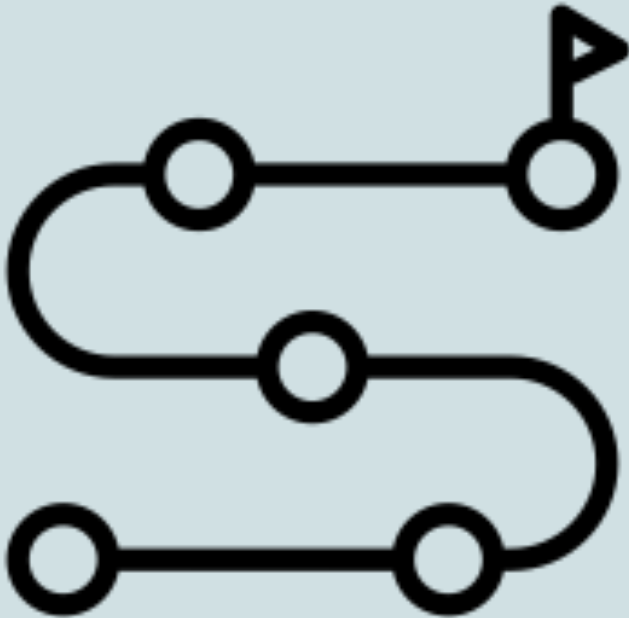
Achievement
