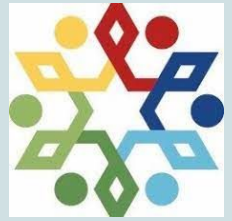


The Kingsway School Foxland Key Messages





Welcome Address



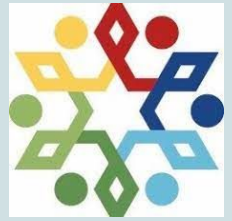

Thank you to everyone who has contributed to the food bank collections. Your efforts will make a significant difference to families in our local community.

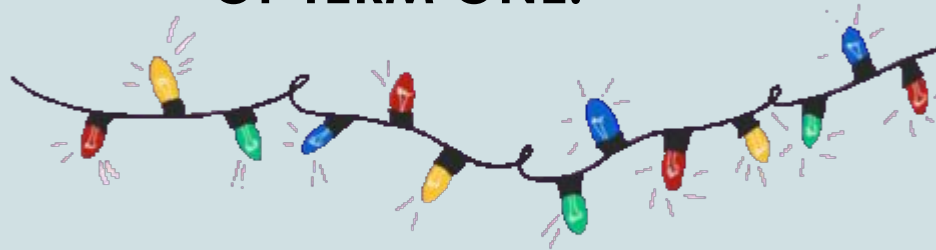

Big Wins



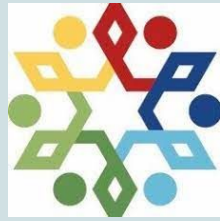
6202 positive points were awarded last week across the school to recognise all the students who have been working productively in their lessons. Well done.

End of term arrangement



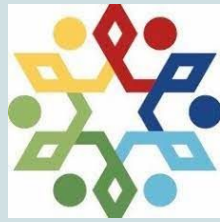
- Expect to be learning as usual in your lessons this week.

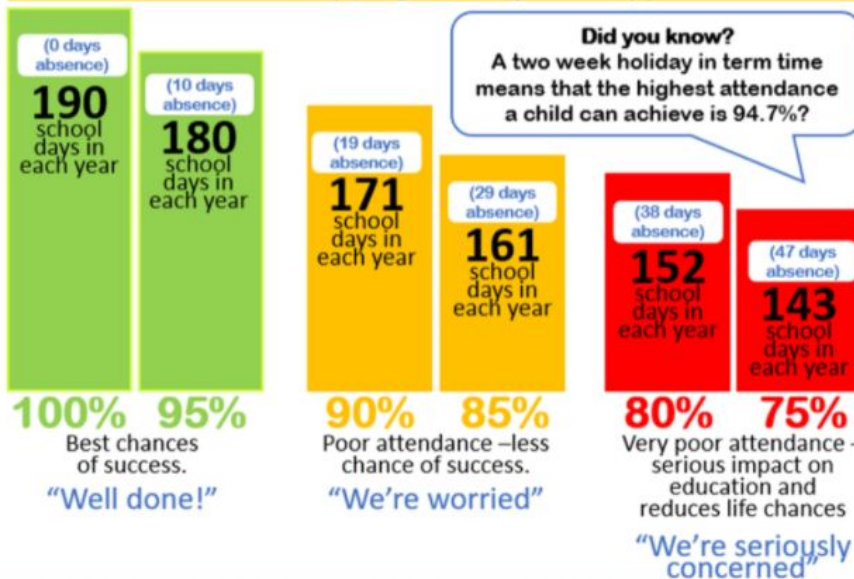

175 days not at school!

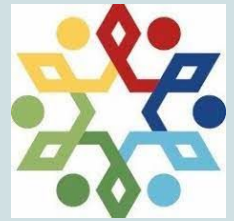

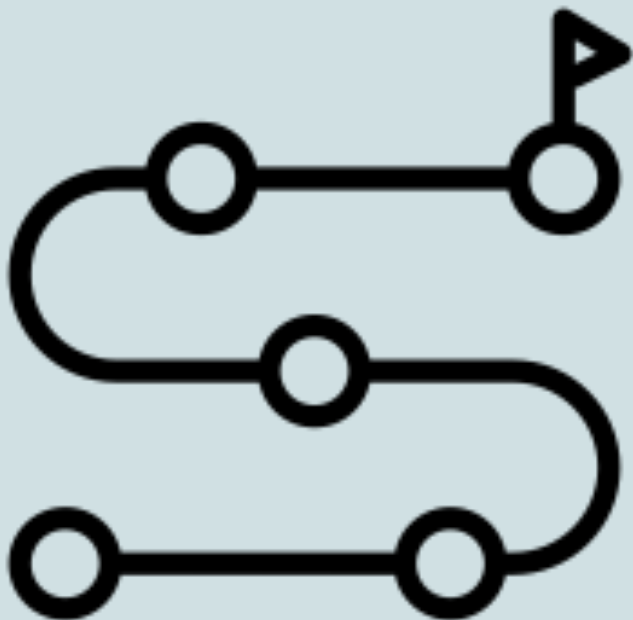
Every Friday there is a prize draw for each year group. Every student who has 100% attendance that week is entered. Winners last week for KS4 were:

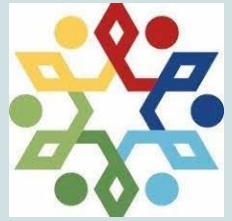
