# Big Wins



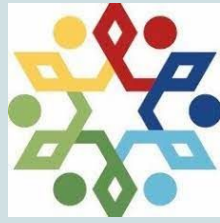
Congratulations to all students who have gained positive points and a “**chicken sticker**” last week.

Great news, students who gained 30 positive points last week will also receive a sticker from SLT.



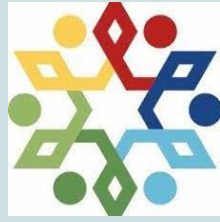

# Ready-Respect-Safe Break Times



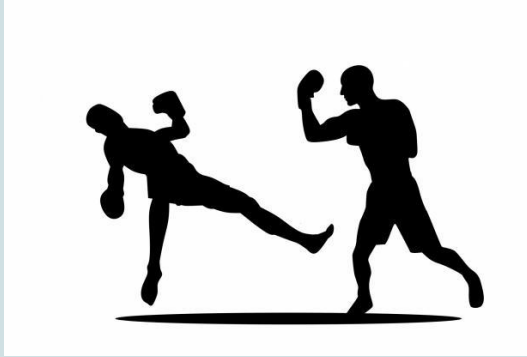
Foxland field will be open B2 **WHEN DRY**. But please note:

# Ready, Respect, Safe Assembly: No Jewellery allowed



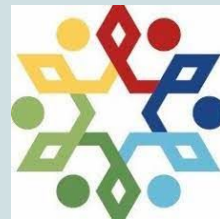
After Easter Holidays:

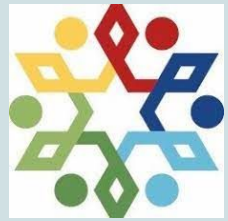

Every week names of students who have 100% attendance are entered into a bigger prize draw that takes place every half term. You must be in school to have a chance of winning.



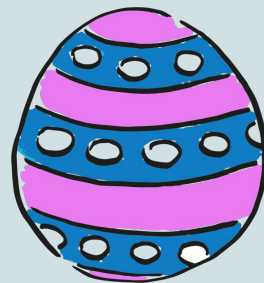
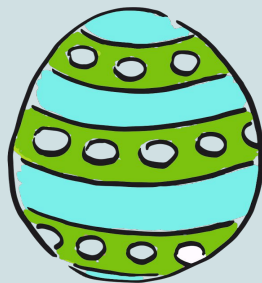
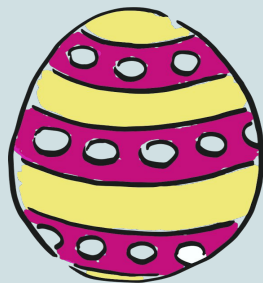
# TKS Easter Egg Challenge

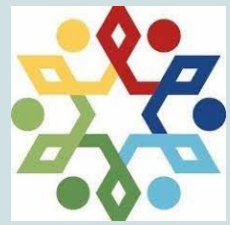
# Opportunity

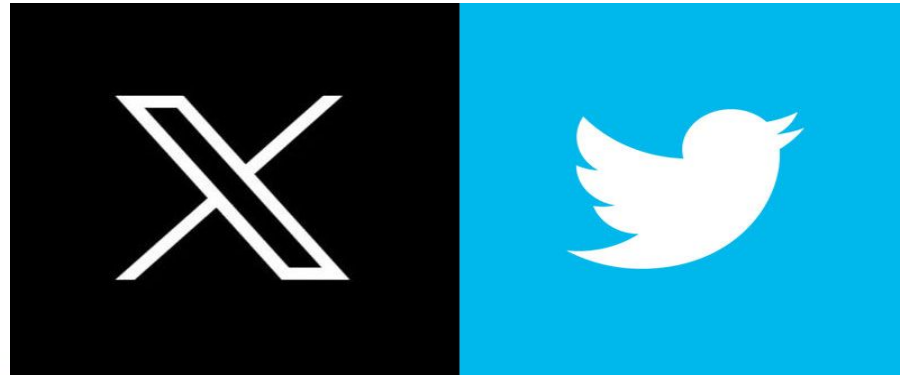




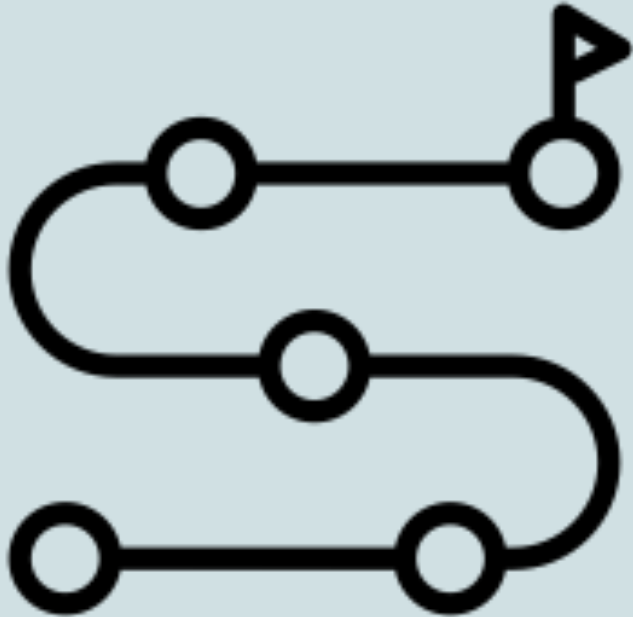
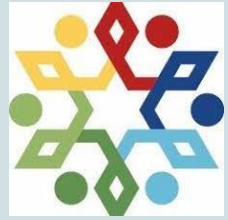

- ☐ Remember if you are in our uniform on the way to/from school you represent TKS.



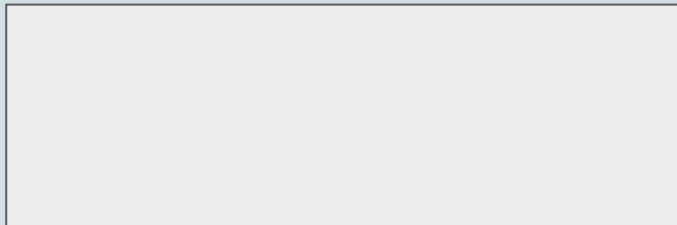
