A revision timetable is the key to making sure you cover everything you need to in time for the exam. It also has the added benefit of breaking everything down into more manageable chunks – revision suddenly feels much less daunting!

A revision timetable contains topics and subjects you need to revise on specific days.

Work out how many revision days you have left until your exams

Decide how much time you will spend revising on each day then

- Make a list of all the exams you need to revise for
- Share the available revision time around each subject and/or exam

Once you've got the basic timetable in place, you can start breaking those subject timings down into topics.
