Rugby training will be on this Thursday due to Mr Duffy being in a meeting on Tuesday.





Why Is Good School Attendance Essential?

Research shows that 17 missed school days a year = 1 GCSE grade drop in achievement (DfES)



There are 365 days in a year

Students are required to attend school for 190 days in a year. This is equal to 52% of a year.

If you attend the 190 school days a year you will achieve 100% attendance.

Students have 175 days holiday each year. This is plenty of time to book appointments.



10 Tips to help you to get to school on time easier.





- 1. Pack your school bag the night before.
- 2. Check you have all your books, PE kit, bus fare and money on your lunch account the night before.
- 3. Make sure your uniform is ready the night before especially after the holidays or weekend.
- 4. Go to bed at a reasonable time so that you have a good sleep.
- 5. Set the alarm clock early enough to allow plenty of time to get ready properly.
- 6. Make sure you have some breakfast.
- 7. Set off for the bus or start walking early enough so that you won't be late: punctuality is important.
- 8. When you arrive to school in the morning go straight to your form room.
- 9. If you are finding work too hard speak to your form tutor in the morning.
- 10. Tell people at home about your day. If you are unhappy about anything then contact the school straight away.


