


The Kingsway School Broadway Key Messages

Key messages: Ready




Planners and Timetables: Since september, there have been lots of changes to the rooms on your timetable. This will continue as we continue to complete work on the building and open new classrooms.

- Completed Options forms must be submitted to Form Tutors by Monday 19th February.





Key Messages: Achievement Sparks Reader: Homework



- You will all be set a weekly Sparx Reader homework
- FIRST HOMEWORK SET: **This Wednesday 24th January 2024**
- FIRST HOMEWORK DUE: **Wednesday 31st January 2024**

- You will have a weekly goal of **300 Sparx Reader Points** (SRP) which equates to about **30 minutes** of reading.

You need to have completed this **as a minimum** each week
BUT complete as much as you can. AIM HIGH!!



Key Messages: Achievement Sparks Reader: Homework



Weekly merits for achieving your 300 SRP.

10,000 SRP = bronze badge

20,000 SRP = silver badge

30,000 SRP = gold badge



Respect: Use of the Canteen




Spring Term Queuing Arrangements:


