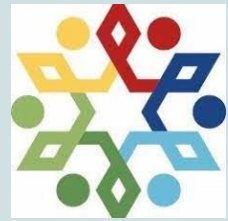

Welcome Address

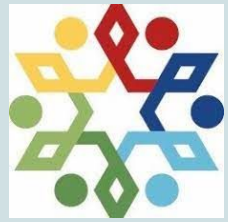

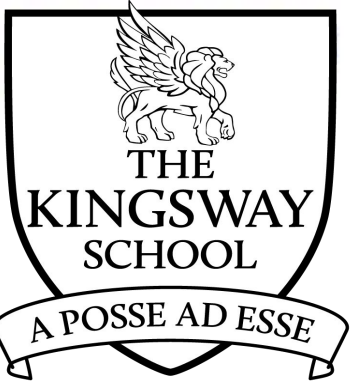

Excellent attitude from all involved and another improved performance!

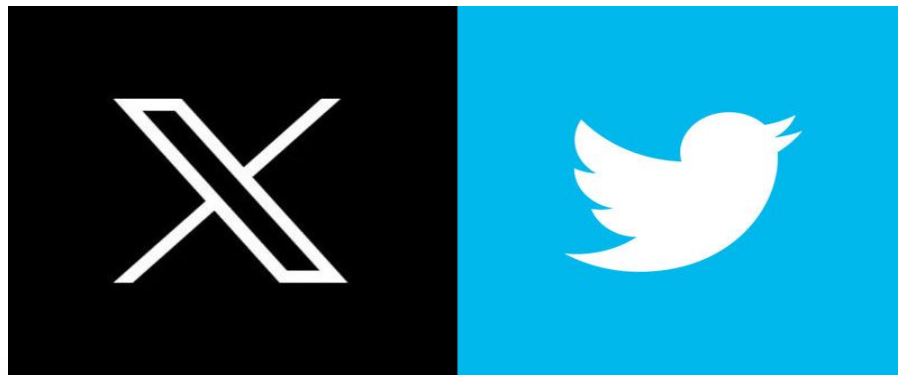

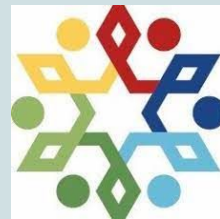

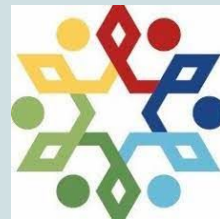

- Completed Options forms must be submitted to Form Tutors by Monday 19th February.

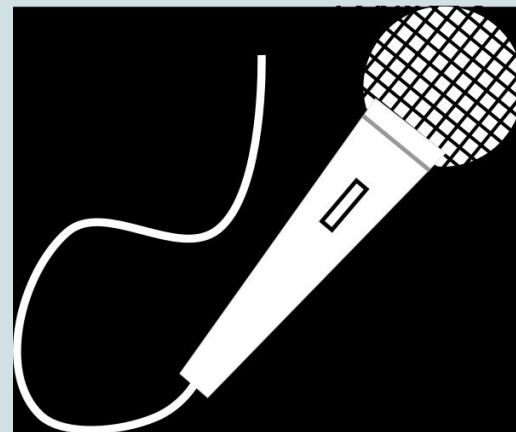

Respect: Communication



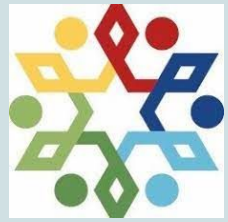
In our school, we strive to speak to each other with kindness and respect. We choose our words carefully.

- Be polite to others (including staff and students)

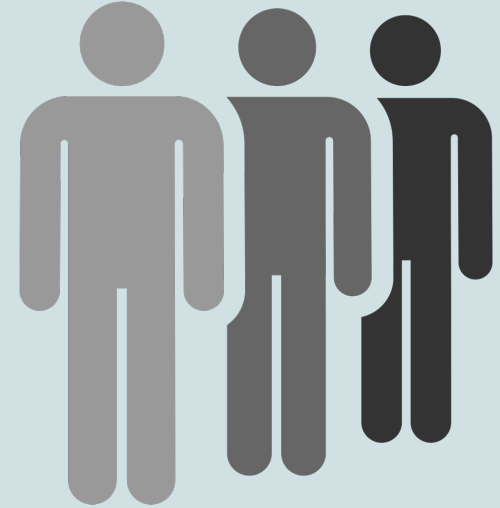


Respect: Use of the Canteen



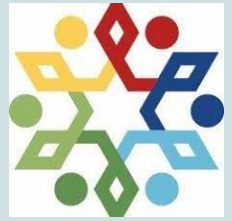
Spring Term:

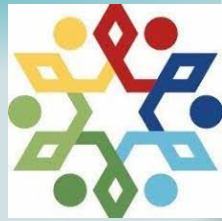
