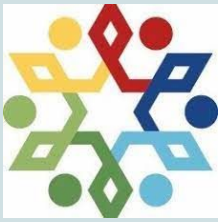

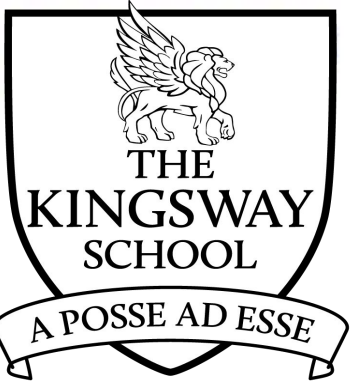

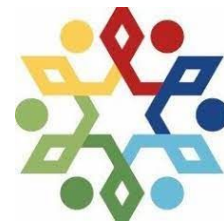

We will try and get onto the grass for tackling practice so please bring your gumshield and warm clothes.

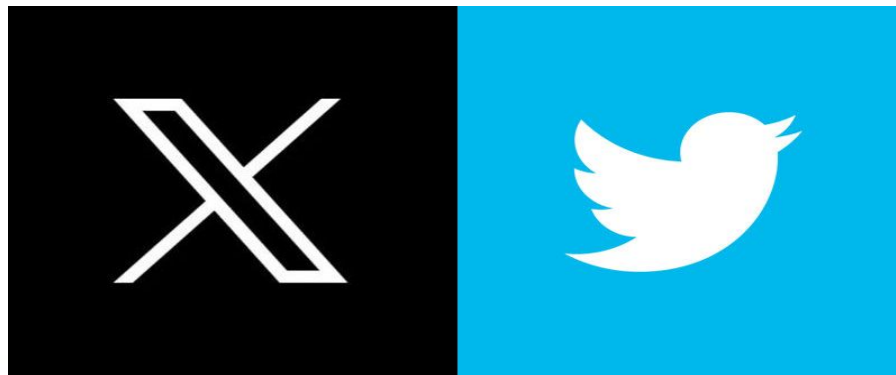

- Planner & Timetable

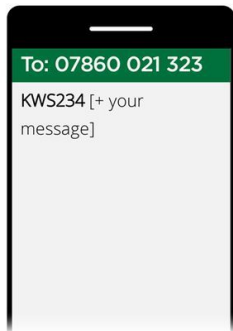

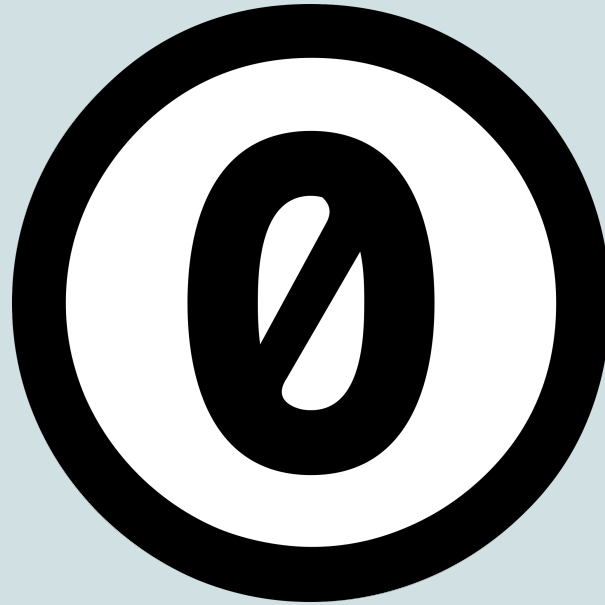
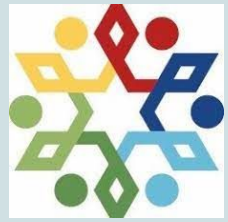

Whisper is back open following the Christmas break and our pastoral teams are on hand to support you and deal with any concerns.



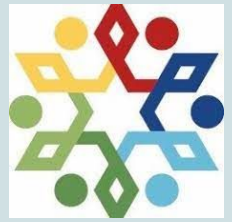
Opportunity: Challenge of the Week

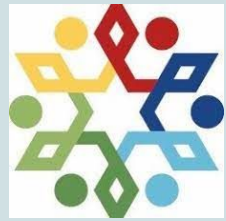


Key Messages: Achievement
