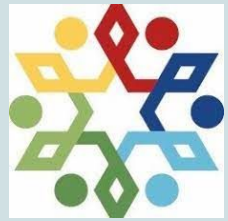


The Kingsway School Foxland Key Messages





Welcome Address



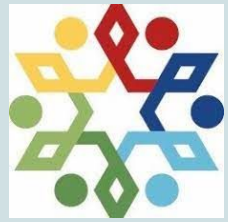

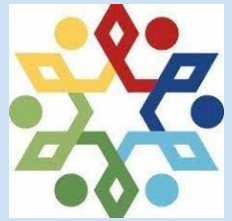
Understanding Your Attendance Percentage

What's in a food box?



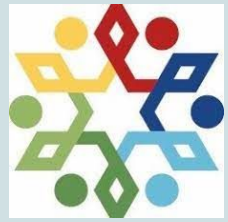
The foodbank has worked with nutritionists to ensure food parcels contain sufficient nutrition for at least three days worth of healthy, balanced meals for individuals and families.

A TYPICAL FOOD PARCEL INCLUDES:

- Breakfast cereals
- Soup
- Pasta
- Pasta sauce
- Tinned beans
- Tinned meat
- Tinned vegetables
- Potatoes
- Tinned fruit
- Tinned tomatoes
- Tea or coffee
- Milk
- Orange juice
- Tinned fish
- Puddings
- Sugar
- Biscuits
- Snacks and treats
- Toiletry items including soap, shampoo, toothpaste
- Nappies and baby wipes



How can you donate?



- 1) Choose an item from the list to bring in
- 2) From Friday 1st December until Friday 15th December please bring your item in
- 3) Deposit your donation in the relevant year group container on your way in to school

Year 11 Pre-Public Exams



- Year 11 Pre-Public Exams take place between Monday 4th December and Friday 15th December.
- Most exams take place in the Foxland Sports Hall - although some exams take place in alternative locations - for example the Library.
- Morning exams start at 9.00am (or 8.45am for students in the Library).
- All afternoon exams start at 1.00pm.
- Students will be dismissed to leave school after finishing afternoon exams - this might be before 3.00pm.



Ready Respect Safe

This week we revisit the importance of our 3 simple rules of Ready Respect Safe

Clear reminders are being given out this week regarding Mobile Phones and electronic devices.

- Mobile phones must be 'Off and away' in classrooms and around school, including the corridors - this means they are out of sight and switched off.

- If seen, these items will be confiscated until the end of the day.
