Whatever, your goal is, achieving it will make you feel empowered to go onto further successes. Good luck and enjoy your first week back!

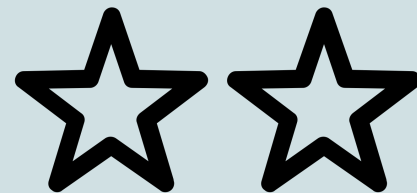
