### **Key Messages: Core Value (Ready)**

### **Key Messages: Core Value (Ready)**



#### Late to School:

Most students on the Broadway campus are on time for school. Those that arrive to school after 8.30 are classed as late to school. If you are late to school, you should report to the main school entrance on Broadway. If you need any essential items of essential uniform or equipment, you will be taken down to The Hub where the staff will help you to get 'ready to learn.



## **Key Messages: Core Value (Ready)**



#### Late to Lessons:

You have been on Broadway campus together for two and a half weeks now and most of you are getting to grips with your timetable. Knowing your timetable and having a copy will support you in being on time for lessons.

Being late to lessons carries sanctions and those that are persistently late to lessons will lose their break times.

# Key Messages: Core Value (Safe) Online safety



Sadly, last week the safeguarding team were alerted that an adult had pretended to be a child to befriend some of our Year 7s on Snapchat. The adult behaved in a very inappropriate way and has been reported to the

police.



These age ratings help keep you safe. Last week, the government passed an Online Safety Bill - the first in the world. This will:

- Enforce age limits.
- Give clear ways for children to report bad things they experience online.
- Hold social media companies responsible for children seeing unsafe content.
