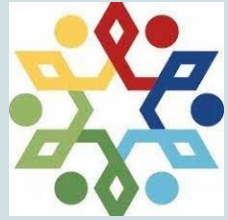


The Kingsway School Broadway Key Messages

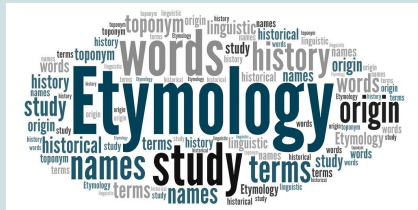
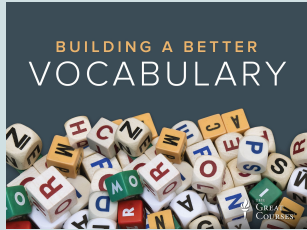


Essential Knowledge from Assembly: Democracy

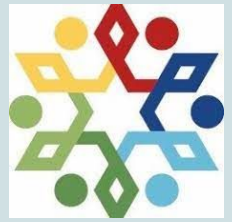
